Is Your Name In The Book?

The Appalachian National Scenic Trail is a designated walking/hiking trail spanning some 2,184 miles between Springer Mountain in Georgia to Mount Katahdin in Maine. There are some individuals, labeled "thru-hikers, who have taken great pride in being able to complete the trail in one hiking season, and once at the end of the trail, they sign a book which chronicles their accomplishment. Given the fact that these "finishers" exerted their energies, braved the elements, and even placed their health at risk, you can understand why one "thru-hiker" vehemently protested to officials of the National Park Service that some people had falsely signed the book indicating they had achieved the goal of completing the hike from beginning to end. It wasn't right, it wasn't fair, the veteran hiker argued, that someone should get credit for something they hadn't done!

Unfortunately, we live in times where more and more people want the prize without having to put forth the effort needed to obtain it. Even more unfortunately, the attitude prevails too often in the spiritual realm. So many individuals want to go to heaven, (and some have even deluded themselves into believing it is their birthright), but they refuse to follow the admonition of Philippians 2:12, Romans 6:3-7 in order to guarantee their residence there! The Pharisees of old, because of their physical and cultural pedigree (Matt. 3:7-10; Rom. 9:15-33) seemed to earnestly believe that their fleshly lineage promised them a covenant relationship with God and that Jehovah in turn was OBLIGATED to afford them spiritual privileges; but both the Master (Jn. 8:31-47) and the apostle Paul (Phil 3:4-9) clearly pointed out who one claims as an ancestor has nothing to do with whether or not a soul is granted the privileges of a son or daughter (Gal. 3:26-29; Rom. 2:25-29). Neither you or I can force the Father to grant us anything- no matter who we are or what we have achieved in life- even if we have completed a work or works in the name of the Father (Matt. 7:21-23).

To have our name written in the Book of Life should be of the utmost importance to each of us, but to insure that it is there at the Judgment (Rev. 20:11-15), we must do the following: (1) Possess the mindset and determination to finish the journey (cf. Heb. 11:8-16; 2 Tim. 4:6-8); and (2) we must do more than just "walk" the trail of life. I can remember when I was in the Boy Scouts and striving to earn a hiking medal at Shiloh National Military Park. To achieve that goal, I had to do more than just walk or hike; I also had specific questions to correctly answer about various monuments and aspects of the battle before I could even hope to be awarded the medal. In the same way, I must, as I journey throughout life, exercise my faith (Heb. 11:6) through God-ordained works and obedience to His will (Eph. 2:10; Titus 2:11:3-8). I cannot hope to have my name written in the Book of Life unless I have taken the time to "answer" the questions God has set before me through His word (Heb. 11:6).

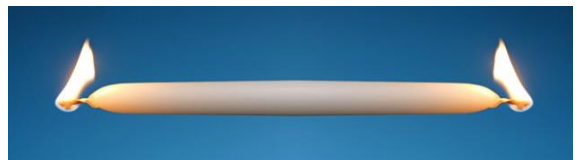

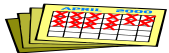
