Ecclesiastes 3:1-2, 9, 17, 22

This morning we will talk about a journey, specifically **your** life's journey and even more specifically, **your** final destination. Not so much your physical journey but your spiritual journey. As a ship sailing out to sea, "as **YOUR** life sets sail."

As a Christian you ultimately only have two destinations, Heaven or Hell. The great, or funny, or happy, or sad thing is with only these two choices...you choose where it will be. As with any journey, being prepared is the best option. You prepare yourself by reading and following your spiritual owner's manual, the Bible.

You prepare yourself by attending church to reinforce your life choice destination. You prepare yourself by setting the example for others to follow.

The biggest thing you can do is to have JOY in your heart, life, and spiritual journey. That JOY first starts with J, Jesus first. With Jesus first in your life, "the peace that passes all understanding" will most certainly follow.

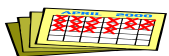

### **Unstable**

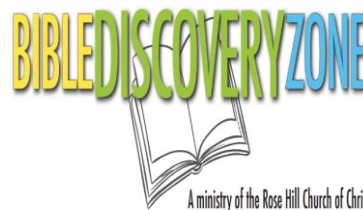
I hope that you've had a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year! Several of us went to exposure and had an incredible time! The theme was The Genius of Jesus. While we were there, we heard so many great lessons and I wanted to briefly discuss one of the points we heard in a lesson.

The lesson started out with the speaker playing a game of Jenga. He was building his tower and once all the pieces were in play then he began to remove pieces and move them towards the top. As he did this the tower became more unstable until it eventually fell. He related this to our pride. He said that when we build up ourselves in pride then all we do is create holes in ourselves and we become unstable and eventually crash.

I loved the analogy especially for its timing. This is a new year. It's 2019 and you have a prime opportunity to think about and plan who you are going to be. Will you build yourself up this year through pride and selfishness or will you be a tower built on the grace of God.

James 4:6 says, "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble." This year think about the person you want to be and realize that God is always your cornerstone and it's in Him that our lives have stability. Find your roots in God this year, humble yourselves and know that God is always in control. If you keep that mindset through this year then you won't be like that unstable Jenga game, but rather a strong tower for God
