At Your Wits' End?

Have you ever had one of those days or weeks when everyone and everything was against you? It may still be that way, even today and it just seems life is closing in on you. How do you cope, endure, or just plain survive? Do you turn to God in prayer or lash out to him in anger and despair (read the book of Job for similar problems)? Do you turn to church members or leaders for help or accuse them of hypocrisy? Worse yet, do you turn to alcohol or drugs or some other type of self-destructive behavior or do you try to drink from the living water that Jesus spoke of? What do you do when you are "at your wits' end?"

There is leadership here at Rose Hill that is willing and ready to help. Realizing that your spiritual help can be just a phone call away, if you allow it. However, you may get advice or solutions exactly what you need or that you do not want to hear. You may have a life problem or mental crisis that you do not want to discuss with someone you know out of embarrassment, shame, or guilt. The Elders here at Rose Hill recognize this and so a couple of years ago Rose Hill entered into a counseling agreement with the Pastoral Institute here in Columbus to deal with your mental well-being and help.

There is a brochure in the foyer. Please pick one up for yourself, a loved one, or someone you know who may be struggling and give it to them. You do not even have to say anything. There is individual, marital, or family counseling available. You just have to reach out and take advantage of it.

What is the cost you ask? There is a \$25 co pay, Rose Hill picks up the rest of the cost if no other insurance is available. Now ask yourself, what is the cost if you do not seek help? Mental and physical pain, loss of family, depression, addiction, or things worse than that can be waiting for you if no help or counseling is sought. Please seek help, if you have no money at all, even for a co pay, seek help anyway. The help will be there.

This help is anonymous. Please use it. No names are given back to Rose Hill, just the number of members seeking help so that the program can be evaluated for its benefit to the members here at Rose Hill. The Elders do not attempt to find out who you are, just if the benefit is being used realizing the Elders must also be good stewards of the Lord's money. The Elders believe wholeheartedly that this program is money well spent if used by those who need it and to those family members that also endure the pain.

If you are having issues, pick up a Pastoral Institute brochure and at least read it. More details of location, help available, and other general info is in it. Strict confidence is adhered to if you come to the Elders here at Rose Hill or the counselors at the Pastoral Institute for help. Whatever your choice may be, please make one today, especially when you are "at your wits' end."

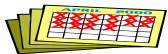

Jesus hears Bartimaeus and calls for him. He asks Bartimaeus in verse 51, "What do you want me to do for you? and the blind man said to him, "Rabbi, let me recover my sight." And Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your faith has made you well."

Even though Bartimaeus was blind he could see that Jesus was the only one that could make a difference. Do you see Jesus in that way? Jesus is the one that will make the difference in your life. Where do you want to be spiritually? Whatever you struggle with and wherever you need to grow, God is the one that helps. God is the one that will guide you. Do you see Him?
