## Be A Barnabas

It was proud moment for me as a parent; in fact, it was a Kodak moment as I heard the names of my children called and watched them step forward to receive their sports' letters and certificates of participation. I hadn't been much of an athlete myself in school, so it did my old heart good to see them gain recognition for their achievements.

In goes without saying; we all need recognition and a pat on the back once in a while, don't we? We need some type of tangible indication we are important, that we count for something, and that our contributions, no matter how meager, can and do make a difference. Without such encouragement from time to time, we begin to doubt our self-worth, we become withdrawn, and we can even come to the conclusion that life is meaningless.

It would be wonderful, in light of our need for recognition, if we all had a Barnabas in our lives. This man, an early disciple of Christ, was dedicated to giving encouragement and to giving back to individuals their sense of value after they had failed in some effort (cf. Acts 15:36-41; 2 Tim. 4:9-13). As long as he was around, people could be sure that they would hear him speak a kind word to them, that he would applaud their efforts, and praise them for whatever contribution they made on behalf of the Kingdom. From what we know of this godly man (Acts 4:36,37; 9:26-30; 11:19-24), we can surmise that he fully understood both the value and need of "patting a person on the back" and of saying "well done".

Yes, it would be great if we all had our personal Barnabas, but do you know what would be better? It would be better if we could all become a Barnabas! Can you picture the impact upon the life of another person if he or she knew that when there was a struggle, when there was an accomplishment, when there was a weakening of the faith, or when there was a reason to rejoice, that someone would always be there to life up the failing heart and cheer then on with, "I'm so proud of you!"? I know it would make a difference in my life if I had someone to acknowledge my good work, someone to help me get back on the right track when I get off course, and someone who would put their arms around me when a crisis crashed into my soul (Rom. 8:28-38; Gal. 6:1,2; 1 Cor. 12:14-26).

We have too many people in our society who like to tear down good and the men and woman who do it, and there are too many men and women who want their egos massaged instead of seeking ways to give the hope of God to those who feel they are hopeless. The Lord needs people who can put aside self and who are ready to aid the spiritually downcast. We need more men and women who truly believe, in all aspects of life, that "it is more blessed to give than receive" (Acts 20:35)! If we would and could approach one another in this fashion, none of us would feel deprived or left out, for there would always be someone at our side to say, "You're not alone; I'm here to help and share!"

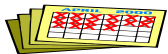

### **Stirred to Give**

Have you ever been compelled to do something? You just saw something, and your gut feeling was that you had to get involved? Maybe you saw someone being bullied or someone in need and you had to step in and help. Maybe there was a fundraiser for a good cause, and you did whatever you could to raise the money or support needed.

We see a similar example in Exodus. In Exodus God instructs Moses on what the Israelites will need so that they can build the Tabernacle. In chapter 35 the Israelites are bringing everything that's needed. Verse 21 says, "And they came, everyone whose heart stirred him, and everyone whose spirit moved him, and brought the LORD's contribution to be used for the tent of meeting, and for all its service, and for the holy garments." Their hearts were stirred, and they were moved to give.

Then in Exodus 36 the people are bringing so many things that Moses has to tell the people to actually stop giving. Verse 7 says, "So Moses gave command, and word was proclaimed throughout the camp, "Let no man or woman do anything more for the contribution for the sanctuary." So, the people were restrained from bringing."

What an awesome example of a giving people! After reading this, what are some ways you can give? Maybe you can give your time, encouragement, or physical blessings. I hope that you find yourself being stirred to give this week. Look for those in need and look for ways that you can help.
