## Cracked Eggs

I'm not much of a grocery shopper, but on occasion, I will volunteer to pick up something from the store for my sweet wife. On one such adventure, Judy asked me to get a carton of eggs. Now, I would be the first to admit that my skills as a shopper are poor, but one thing I remember being taught, even as a child, is that you always open the container to make sure no eggs are broken- a simple exercise and wise precaution, right? Well, my little excursion into the world of eggs that day was anything but simple, because I ended up going through ten different cartons before I found one with a dozen eggs intact!

Since the time of my trip to the store, I've had the chance to ask, "Why in the world had I been so choosy about those eggs? Why didn't I just pick up that first carton with its one cracked egg and pay for it?" After all, almost 92% of the contents were good, and I wouldn't have been sacrificing but a few cents to pay full price for less than a complete package! Then I asked myself, "Why SHOULD I pay full price for something that gave me less than full benefit?" I also realized I didn't buy a carton of eggs when one was broken because I feared contamination, and finally, I didn't purchase that carton because a few cents DID matter to my pocketbook!

Now allow me to make a spiritual application from the above incident. When God saw that the man He created would struggle and often be mired in sin, He made up His mind to redeem that which was "cracked" (1 Pet. 1:18-25). He was fully aware that men suffered from a contamination of the soul and that not just one, but all of them (Rom. 8:23), stood in need of redemption. Despite this condition, His incomparable love motivated Him to offer a purchase of mankind through His Son (1 Cor. 6:19,20). The Lord was very much aware of the fact that we would be damaged goods (Rom. 5:6-11), but He was still willing to pay full price for the opportunity to possess us (Jn. 3:14-18). We were in essence, a whole carton of spiritually cracked eggs! Can we not fully appreciate His love and compassion? Do we daily rejoice over the fact that in Christ, we no longer have to be contaminated by unrighteousness (Rom. 6:12-23) nor do we have to fear contaminating others with evil (Matt. 18:1-7)? If we are thinking rationally, then we will joyfully and consistently respond to this grace and mercy, our hearts will cry out in gratitude, and praise will be forthcoming because God didn't cast us aside due to the fact, we were damaged and unfit (Rom. 5:6-11). We can be His, but we must want to be purchased and be made whole!

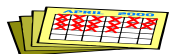
