He Is Coming Back!

Today is the day the religious world has set aside as a yearly commemoration of Christ's resurrection. While there is no evidence in scripture that the early saints had such an annual observance, we are encouraged by the fact that modern man is at least stopping to consider the eternal significance of Jesus arising from the grave. That the resurrection is a foundational doctrine and that has an undeniable connection to one's salvation is certainly a biblical truth that the ancient Christians and we can't neglect to live and teach. In truth, the Bible treats the doctrine of the resurrection as a lifestyle doctrine, one which is to permeate our thinking on a daily basis.

Why is understanding the resurrection so crucial to our spiritual well-being? **First, if there had been no resurrection, then there could be no forgiveness of sin** (1 Cor. 15:17). Scripture declares that had Jesus not come from the grave, everything He did on the cross would have been ineffective. The resurrection represents the culmination of His atoning act, and therefore, if we don't believe in and teach it as fact, we have a useless faith and we are still plagued by our sins.

Second, the resurrection is a declaration that Christ is the ultimate victor over a cruel enemy! Death is, to many, the cruelest of all foes. It destroys unions, wounds love, breaks hearts, creates upheaval in families, and leaves in its wake a sense of pain and often a sense of hopelessness. Jesus overcome death (cf. Matt. 16:18,21; Acts 2:27) and promised that it would be vanquished (1 Cor. 15:24-26) in the end. His resurrection is a pledge that death won't be victorious over us.

Third, the resurrection heralds hope! In 1 Thessalonians 4, we read where there were some who were struggling with uncertainties concerning the fate of loved ones who had died in the Lord. It was Paul's intention to provide them with some absolutes that would remove those doubts and fears (cf. 1 Thess. 4:18). First, He declared that those loved ones were simply sleeping by using a term to indicate their situation was but temporary. Just as the body doesn't cease to exist when a person is sleeping, so the soul does not cease to exist when it is separated from the body at death; and second, He urged them not to sorrow as those who have no hope.

The enemies of Jesus- most notably Satan- believed that when Christ died on that cross that all their "problems" had come to an end. His movement was finished, His followers were finished, and His teachings were finished! But the discarded grave clothes in the tomb sent a different message; the Savior wasn't done! He had been resurrected and He was coming back!

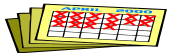

A Living Sacrifice

Have you ever thought about the sacrifices of the old testament? They were usually pretty messy. A lot of the sacrifices required the death of an animal. The process that would happen was pretty gross and rightfully so because our sin is gross. Then when you think about the sacrifice of Christ, we see how gruesome that was as well. The sacrifice for our sin required death. It took the death of an animal in the old testament and then Christ came and was our perfect sacrifice to wash away our sins.

Christ's sacrifice didn't end at His death because He came back from the dead. He became alive again. He was the sacrifice that was living and the sacrifice that gives life to all. In Romans 12 we are called to be like Christ. In verse 1 it says, "I urge you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship."

So, what does being a "living and holy sacrifice" look like? It says that it's our "spiritual service of worship," but what does that really look like in our lives? Hebrews 13 gives us a clearer picture on what our sacrificial lives should look like. Hebrews 13:15-16 says, "Through Him then, let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name. And do not neglect doing good and sharing for with such sacrifices God is pleased."

Our lives should be filled with praising God and doing good to those around us. Remind yourself of all the things God has done for you and let that fill your heart till it overflows in praise to God and love towards others.
