The Instincts of a Mother

Have you ever tried to peek inside a nest where there were eggs or newly hatched birds? Take it from me; the mother bird doesn't take too kindly to any type of intrusion, no matter how innocent! She sees the curiosity seeker as a threat, and as such, she will do all she can to drive away the perceived danger. It makes no difference to this mother how big or fierce the opponent is- she will fight for the survival of her "children"!

A mama bird does things by instinct. She builds a nest, gives life, feeds her young, and guards her home because that's the way the Lord made her, and she will continue to do these things for as long as her babies need her. I truly believe that God has placed, in just about every type of "mother", these instincts- I know He did with a human Mom! We can look back and see how our precious mothers continually gave of themselves to see that their children, before they left the "nest," had the opportunities to become strong, develop good character, and grow close to Jehovah. Even now we can look in a mother's eyes, and instead of seeing a multitude of hurts, disappointments, and pain we children may have caused, we see affection, forgiveness, and pride. We see a willingness and determination to defend her young (we will always remain her child) against the attackers, to take away their hurts, to comfort them, and to encourage them not to lose heart or faith when so much around them seems hopeless and faithless. But perhaps the greatest instinct a godly mother has is the ever increasing desire to see that her children are true to the Lord, and that they live in such a way so as to have God welcome them into blissful eternity when the Son comes again.

May each of us praise the Father for a mother's instincts to guard her "nest" and for her determination to raise her children in a righteous manner so that they can indeed, "fly" straight to the Lord.

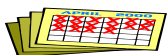
