## The Forgiveness of God

"Gavrilo Princip, who shot Archduke Franz Ferdinand, got the chance to assassinate him because the archduke's driver made a wrong turn. Had the driver gone the right way, World War I might not have happened, and the history of the 20th century could have been completely different. From the first gunshot fired in anger in 1914 to the 11th hour of the 11th day on the 11th month in 1918, the Great War took its toll on human life. Of the 65 million men who fought in World War 1: 8 million men were killed in battle, 2 million died of illness and disease, 21.2 million were wounded., 7.8 million were taken prisoner or went missing in action. The total cost of World War I to the United States (was) approximately \$32 billion, or 52 percent of gross national product at the time." *(information gleaned from various sources)*

When you look at the human and financial tolls that fighting World War I took upon the world, and when you then realize that one simple mistake was the catalyst for the conflict, you can't help but shake your head in sadness. Though every mistake a person makes doesn't have the catastrophic magnitude associated with WWI, our miscues, especially those of a spiritual nature, do have impacts upon our souls, as well affecting others in some negative way. The godly heart seeks forgiveness, but tragically there are those times when man won't forgive our trespasses, As a result, we can become so discouraged in having to carry the weight of shame that we might become unable to believe we have worth or that there could ever be anything good about ourselves.

I'm glad the God of heaven isn't like man when it comes to extending pardon for our wrongs. It's stressful enough to ask our peers for forgiveness and not receive it, but what would it be like emotionally and spiritually if Jehovah became intractable regarding our pleas for cleansing? Think of how heavy the load of guilt, regret, and shame would be if we had no means of gaining relief! But the good news is that God isn't like man, and for the penitent, there's a continual, unquenchable supply of forgiveness (Matt. 18:21-35)! For the one who has had sins remitted by the blood of Christ (Acts 2:38; Heb. 9:13-22; Rom. 6:1-7), there is an assurance that when he or she approaches the throne of grace to seek pardon, there won't be anything less than full forgiveness (1 Jn. 1:8,9)! An additional promise accompanying this release is that our sins are remembered no more and are cast into the depths of the sea (Heb. 8:12; Micah 7:19)!

The knowledge that our spiritual mistakes can be so corrected should fill us with gratitude and motivate us to be more forgiving of others. We can't expect release from our guilt if we don't extend such "release" to one another (Matt. 5:7; 7:1-5; Lk. 17:3,4).

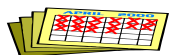
