When We Say "Amen"

It normally comes at the end of a prayer, but it's not unusual to hear someone say it during the course of a sermon or Bible class lesson. As you examine Scripture, you will discover the word was uttered by individuals who were in essence declaring an **intent** as well as an **agreement**. Though we have often read this word, heard it said, or even said it ourselves, the chances are we may not actually know what it means, and the sense of ownership being demanded when it's expressed. What is this mystery word? It is the word **AMEN**. Simply put, when an individual declares it (publicly or privately), he or she is saying, "Let it be so, I'm in total agreement with what has been said," and it is a declaration before God and man that we assent to all of what has been said or read. To say AMEN means that we are taking a stand, that we will be obedient to a particular truth and that we are confessing before heaven and earth that we have an intent we will fulfill. Expressing an AMEN can be one measurement or our spiritual integrity.

There are at least three ways we can offer an AMEN to the will and law of God: (1) *We can of course verbally state the word.* Remember, when we say it, we are dedicating ourselves to living that to which we give agreement and that we are taking responsibility for being a consistent example of the truth we "amen," Others may be watching us to see if we actually live up to the AMEN; (2) *we can pronounce an AMEN through the way we conduct ourselves during the day!!* We cannot say we belong to Christ and that we have offered ourselves as a holy, living sacrifice (Rom. 12:1,2) if we do not consistently live in accordance with the Father's will (Lk. 6:46; Jn. 14:15); and (3) *we can say AMEN to truth by possessing the right attitude concerning our response to trial, chaos, disappointment, and hardship.* There are going to be hardships and trials in life, but we do not have to surrender our discipleship and faith to circumstances. We're told we're never going to be subjected to more than we can handle and that God will provide us both comfort and strength when the dark days seek to encase us in fear and despair (1 Cor. 10:13; 2 Cor. 1:3,4; Rom. 8:28-38). If we believe (say AMEN to) the promises of Jehovah to sustain us in those times of upheaval, then we will always be able to raise our voice and declare, God will provide!

Expressing an AMEN in word, deed, or in thought is serious business, but for those who understand the word's significance and who strive to live in accordance with its meaning, there is truly an abundant life to be lived and a joy to be embraced.

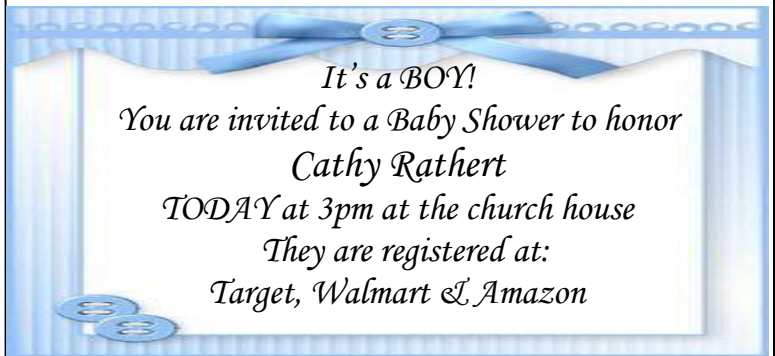

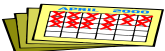

Breaking the Limit

What is the longest amount of time that you've stayed awake? You had some reasons to stay up and as it got later and later you kept reminding yourself of that reason. You probably drank coffee or maybe an energy drink to help you stay awake. Maybe you ate something or watched something to help you stay awake. Regardless of what you did to stay awake, sooner or later you fell asleep. At some point your body said, "That's it! I've had enough! I am falling asleep whether you want to or not!"

We have our limits. We can only go so long without sleep before our bodies will force us to sleep. We can only go so long without food or water before our bodies will stop working the way they should. What is incredible as limited individuals is that we serve a God that breaks limitations. In Psalm 136 we read a psalm of praise to God. It's a psalm of thanksgiving to God because of His enduring love. His love that breaks limitations.

The Psalm is 26 verses and every single one of them repeats a specific phrase, "for His lovingkindness is everlasting." It really is a beautiful Psalm and I would encourage you to read the whole thing but the first couple of verses give us a great appreciation for our God.

Psalm 136:1-4 says, "Give thanks to the Lord for He is good; For His lovingkindness is everlasting. Give thanks to the God of gods, For His lovingkindness is everlasting. Give thanks to the Lord of lords, For His lovingkindness is everlasting. To Him who alone does great wonders, For His lovingkindness is everlasting."

Take some time to read that Psalm and appreciate the everlasting nature of God's power and love.
