## Customer Service

I had a 10:00 am appointment and I was still in my seat at 10:30 waiting to be seen. Aggravation was staring to set in when I stopped and remembered that a Christian was to exhibit patience. I calmed down, and as I continued to wait to be served, I happened to notice a sign on the wall: *If you are grouchy, irritable, or just plain mean, we will charge you \$10 for just having to put up with you!* At first I was amused at the "warning", but then I began to wonder if the sign was really meant as a joke or if it had been put up because there had been so many customer complaints about the company's service.

Do you realize that as children of God, we're in the **service** business? Oh, we're not pedaling the truth or employing gimmicks to entice others to come to Christ (2 Cor. 2:17), but nonetheless, our actions and attitudes can have a tremendous impact upon the way others perceive Christ and His Church (cf. 1 Pet.2:9-15). Rather than being an obstacle to a struggling soul finding life in Christ, we must do all within our power to be of such service to mankind that its heart becomes open and receptive to both hearing about and searching for salvation through the Savior. We want to be the "fragrance of God's knowledge in every place" (2 Cor. 2:14), and the "aroma of life leading to life" (2 Cor. 2:15,16), so we must do what we can to render proper and beneficial service to both Jehovah and man (cf. Lk. 2:52). How can we accomplish this duty and privilege? How can we render godly "customer service"?

- (1) **Start with our self** by making sure that we are in the faith (2 Cor. 13:5; 2 Jn. 8; Phil. 2:12,13; Rom. 12:1,2).
- (2) **Live as if you have a joyful, abundant life** (Jn. 10:10). Count your blessings (Psalm 68:19), smile and laugh (Prov. 15:13), pray without ceasing (1 Thess. 5:17), and think good thoughts so that you can have great days (cf. Phil. 4:8,9). If we greet others with a smile, with genuine joy in our hearts, and with words that are as precious jewels, then they will come to believe that what we have in Christ is worth their embracing as well.
- (3) **Have the proper attitude toward teaching truth** (Eph. 4:15; Prob. 15:1,28). Take the time to understand where someone is in his spiritual journey (Acts 8:26-39; 1 Cor. 9:19-23; Acts 17:22-31) and try to identify with their perspective.
- (4) **See the soul, not the person** (cf. 2 Cor. 5:14-17). Don't allow the antagonism, doubt, skin color, culture, and "baggage" prevent you from serving (Gal. 6:10) all men and women. Just as Christ died for all, we must be willing to serve all!

Let us sow truth so that God can reap souls (1 Cor. 3:5-7) but let us continually be aware of the fact that if we are not servicing mankind properly, we hinder the Lord's providential effort to bring about an increase.

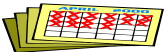

### **A Good Attitude**

Have you ever wondered what Jesus was like? What his personality would be like? What would His attitude be like towards everything? We read about how He treated others and loved those that were around Him. We see how He would go out of His way for others and treat them with respect. In one case we read about His specific attitude that led Him to do these things.

Philippians 2:5 says, "Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus" but what was the attitude that Jesus demonstrated that we are supposed to have? In verses 3 and 4 we see what Paul is talking about. He says, "Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind let each of you regard one another as more important than himself; do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others."

That is the attitude that Jesus had. He was humble even though He was the Son of God. He treated others as more important than Himself even though He has been around before the world began. Think about that for a minute. When Jesus was here, He didn't parade around talking about how powerful He was. Instead He treated others as more important than Himself.
