## The Right Kind of Seed

It's a radio commercial I had heard before, but for some reason, I hadn't really given the script much attention; but when I heard it a few weeks later, there were some things said that really peaked my interest. The company, called *Survival Seed Bank*, wanted to impress upon the public that there was a real possibility that a genuine food crisis was on the horizon. Sure enough, the president of the seed bank on his website, offered "evidence" that a world food shortage was near and that simply stockpiling commodities wouldn't alleviate the problem in the long run. One reason suggested for the impending shortage had to do with the fact that when man genetically engineers seed, he renders it sterile and thus incapable of reproducing itself. In short, the pitch was that if you wanted to survive the coming crisis, you must use the right kind of seed!

In Luke 18:11 and Matthew 13:18-23, Jesus told a parable about a farmer who sowed his seed on different types of ground. Depending upon the condition of the soil, the seed died, began to grow but later died, or was choked out by the thorns. The Master then fully explained in whose life the seed would bountifully reproduce. How can we be sure that the right seed is planted in our hearts?

First and foremost, ***we must never lose sight of the fact that what we allow to be sown in our heart will produce some type of fruit.*** Just as an apple seed will produce an apple, tomato seeds tomatoes, and cabbage seeds cabbage, only the word of God can produce Christians (1 Pet. 1:22-25; Rom. 10:10-17). There is no ***ism*** "seed" that can help one find Christ and teach the soul he must be born again (Jn. 3:3-5; Rom. 6:3-11; Acts 17:16-34).

Second, ***the seed cannot be a hybrid- a mixture of truth spliced with human tradition, arrogance, or opinion passed off as truth because "it just makes sense"*** (cf. Matt. 15:8,9; Gal. 1:6-9). When we intertwine human desire, philosophies, dogmas, and fantasy with the pure word, the seed becomes sterile, incapable of producing a first century Christian in the twenty-first century.

Finally, ***we must be careful about from whom we "buy" the seed*** (Prov. 23:23). Just as there were religious peddlars and hucksters in the first century (2 Cor. 2:17; Matt. 24:4-6; Acts 20:28-30), we have men and women today who will try everything within their power to "sell" spiritual seed that will produce nothing but weeds or drawf fruit. We are obligated to make sure that whenever a person speaks for God that he truly is speaking His oracles (1 Pet. 4:11). If we do not follow the lead of the Bereans (Acts 17:11), we will end up with a spiritual hunger and possibly with an eternal starvation.
