## Pleasing My Dad

A long time ago in the city of Memphis, TN, all motorists were expected to take cars through an inspection station to make sure they were being operated in a safe manner. The inspection was a pretty rigorous one and each aspect of the testing (emissions, brakes, emergency brake, turn signals, and properly aligned headlights) had to be passed before the car was considered legal. As an adult, I always feared that my vehicles would flunk at least one of the tests, but it was when I was a teen still living at home that I had greatest fear of failure at inspection time. Dad and mom were going in a mini-vacation and the last instruction he gave me was to take the old '60 Falcon through inspection. The only problem was the car had suffered a minor accident that required a headlight being replaced. This meant it had to be correctly aligned before the vehicle could pass inspection. I really didn't know what I was doing, but somehow, I devised a plan that helped me do an alignment I hoped would meet the city standard. Imagine my relief when each attendant punched the place on the ticket indicating everything- including the headlight alignment- had passed!

When I look back that "scary and uncertain" time, I realize that dad was in essence trying to teach me some very valuable life lessons. First, *I learned from that failure wasn't an option.* Dad believed I could do the task or else he wouldn't have given me the responsibility. Second, *I discovered that a plan based upon a standard would yield success.* In devising my alignment plan, I remembered the method used at the testing station and then tried to duplicate those conditions on my garage door. It worked! Third, *I understood what it took to produce genuine pride in accomplishing a task.* I could hardly wait for dad to get home and take a look at the windshield displaying that inspection sticker. It was indeed one of the first things he did, and his look of approval filled me with a true sense of self-esteem. Finally, *I felt an almost unspeakable joy in having pleased my father!* His approval was important to me, and that is why an incident that happened over 50 years ago has such a warm place in my memory.

But as I look at that episode of growing up, I also realize that dad meant for those lessons to be transferred to my relationship with the Heavenly Father. If I truly want to meet His expectations of me (1Cor. 3:9-11), I won't want to let Him down. He has given me the pattern for spiritual success (2 Tim. 3:16,17) and I can take pride in knowing that when He inspects my life on that last day, I will have pleased Him and thus hear Him say, "Enter into the joy of your Lord." My "light" will indeed have been so aligned that I would have no fear of passing that inspection (2 Cor. 5:10,11)!

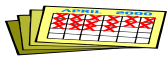
