Suppose There had been no sacrifice?

Suppose in 1776 when the "colonists" signed that famous document declaring their independence, they decided the next day it was all a mistake and then begged the King of England to forgive them for even thinking about an insurrection. *Where would we be now?*

As monumental an event as the American Revolution was, its significance really pales in comparison to the *cause of freedom* championed by Almighty God! Even before man's creation, Jehovah saw there was going to be a war, a continual series of battles between the Godhead and Satan for the souls of mankind (1 Pet. 1:17-21). The first salvo was fired in the Garden of Eden when Adam and Eve succumbed to the temptation of the Serpent (Gen. 3:1-19). The devil undoubtedly believed that with his initial shot, the conflict would end, and he would emerge victorious; but the Lord of heaven fired right back and promised Satan (through what is considered to be the first prophecy concerning Christ (Gen. 3:15), that he couldn't and wouldn't be triumphant in the end! Suppose though that God hadn't fought back. *Where would we be spiritually?* Suppose He hadn't really cared that we had the chance to be free- free from the burden of sin, free from the shackles of shame, free from the restraints of regret- *where would we be now?*

Guess what; we don't have to ask such questions or worry about the tragic consequences of a non-intervening God because He not only became involved in the war on our behalf, but He also committed all the resources necessary- including the ultimate sacrifice of His only begotten Son (Jn. 3:16; Rom. 5:6-11)- to make liberty possible for those who would desire to be set free (Jn. 1:12; Jn. 8:23-38). The question is though, "**How many of us love spiritual freedom so much that we are motivated to genuinely appreciate and pursue the liberty offered by the Father through the Son** (Rom. 6:1-18)? Answering this question is the key to one's redemption and ability to celebrate spiritual freedom. Sadly, some individuals won't do what is necessary to gain their liberation through Christ because they: (a) *have gotten use to living as slaves* (Rom. 1:18-32); (b) *are afraid the power of the captor is greater than the power of the Liberator* (Jn. 9:1-22; 12:43; 1 Jn. 4:4); or (c) *aren't willing to involve themselves in doing what Jehovah requires of them to gain their freedom* (Rom. 12:1,2; Heb. 11:6)!

Oh, how wonderful it is to be able to celebrate our country's independence and to solemnly reflect upon the sacrifices our forefathers wrought in bringing about our freedom; but it's a grander thing to contemplate the freedom to be had through Christ (Gal. 5:1)! If we all would allow ourselves to just focus upon the cost Jehovah paid to liberate our souls, I'm convinced that we'd be better able to appreciate the loving and unalterable decision He made to provide us with an opportunity to gain and maintain real freedom!

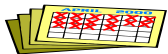
