The Blessings Aren't Postponed

A number of years ago, an elderly couple made provisions in their will to leave their cash-strapped small northeast town some \$18,000. I'm sure that the city officials didn't want the man and woman to pass away, but when the event did occur, I imagine there was a mild euphoria concerning the fact that the treasury would receive a much-needed cash infusion. But the jubilation soon turned to despair when city officials learned about a very unusual provision regarding the receipt of the gift; it could not be touched for 100 years! Now even though it was calculated this money would accrue enough interest to total 9.9 million dollars over that period of time, those in power decided that such a "windfall" wouldn't be worth the wait. Since the city couldn't get the \$18,000 right away, it was decided that the will would be contested in court!

In light of the story, I'm reminded of the inheritance and blessings Christians have been promised by the Father in heaven (Eph. 3:14-21). Those grand benefits were made possible by someone's- Christ- death, and yes, there is a provision to His will which must be adhered to before one can be a legitimate heir and benefactor (Gal. 4:1-9). But is there a waiting period before the blessings can be enjoyed, before receipt of the gift can be used to dispel crisis and despair? If we look upon this inheritance in the ultimate sense, i.e., eternity in heaven, then yes, we will have to wait before the complete end to all life's crises will be realized (Rev. 21:4; 22:14-17). But that doesn't mean we are totally deprived of the Lord's kindnesses and spiritual treasures now, or that we have to take him to "court" to "contest" His will! No, as Christians, we have a Father who knows what we need before we ask (Matt. 6:8), who knows the number of hairs upon our head (Matt. 10:30), and who uses angels to minister to His children (Heb. 1:14). God did not give us a promise of an abundant life (Jn. 10:10) and then decide to withhold those things which will bring such a life into existence.

Stop and really contemplate the great inheritance we possess from Jehovah even now. We have: (1) *Freedom from sin* (2) *continual cleansing when we fall* (1 n. 1:5-10); (3) *a fellowship of believers* (1 Cor. 12:13-27); (4) *the sunshine and rain, the hot and cold weather, and the physical senses to enjoy it*; (5) *a Book, His word, by which we learn how to develop and maintain the best relationships in life*; but (6) most of all, God has given us a substantial purpose and hope.

Remember, the above blessings are not being withheld from any child of the King. Take hold of that which has been granted to you, and the treasury of your heart will overflow with God's rich grace

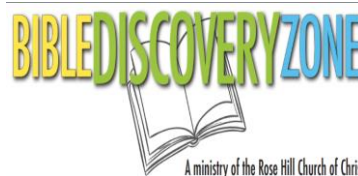
