Fight for Your Life

Have you ever had something worth fighting for? Was there ever something that you were so passionate about that you would do anything to protect it? Was there ever a time when that part of your life was under attack? How did you respond? Generally, when we talk about a physical danger/attack we hear about the fight or flight response. Do we stand up in those moments or do we go the other way?

We know that there are things worth fighting for and things that are not. We need to take a personal inventory and see what in our lives are truly valuable. Physical possessions come and go. Your families are vital. Your soul is precious beyond belief. When you see what is important then you can begin to see where different attacks can come from. That which is truly important is the same thing that Satan wants to break.

We must recognize where Satan is putting pressure and we must rise in confidence. Ephesians 6 talks about spiritual warfare. Paul writes about what we are up against. He says in verse, "For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places." While the forces that he talks about may seem daunting he follows this up with the next verse. He writes, "Therefore, take up the full armor of God, that you may be able to resist in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm."

We are to recognize what is against us and we are to stand firm. What's interesting is that every strength and help that we get isn't from ourselves, but it is from God. He goes on to write about the armor of God. He talks about the belt of truth, the breastplate of righteousness, shoes of the gospel, the shield of faith, the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit. All of these things that we are to be armed with come from God.

The whole reason we are able to stand up and stand firm is because of God. It's not because we are so brave or courageous, but because God gives us the strength and the ability to resist when those attacks come. When we look at the concept of spiritual warfare, we see a common theme. That theme is that victory is **always** found through God. James 4:7 says, "Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you." We submit to God, we give ourselves to Him, we allow ourselves to be molded to His image, and we find the strength through Him.

Are you fighting? Are you giving it everything you've got? God gave all of Himself for you. Find your strength in Him and stand firm in your faith.

Your Family

What is something that you find honorable? It may be a cause that you find honorable or maybe a person. You found a reason to hold whatever or whomever it is to a higher position than other things. You see that cause or individual as admirable. It goes without saying that whatever you honor you also find important.

In Ephesians 6:2 we are told to "Honor your father and mother." This means listening, obeying (which is mentioned in verse 1), and treating them with respect. This isn't an article about how you need to be a better child for your parents, but rather how you view them, and how you view your family.

Your family is important. God cares deeply about families and recognizes the struggles that families face. He's known those struggles from the very beginning with Adam, Eve, Cain, and Abel. This is a circular pattern that God has designed. We should honor our parents as they guide us. Our parents should guide us in a way that is honorable. Your family is important, your parents are important, and you are important. God designed the family to be a team, but a team only works when it is working together.
