THE FIELD GUIDE TO BEING A GENIUS

How do you handle being the smartest person ever? It's a big responsibility, but someone has to do it. It just so happens that it has fallen on your shoulders. Okay so you (technically) may not be the smartest person ever, but every piece of advice you give is always right, right? So how do you handle that amount of wisdom?

James 3 sympathizes with the burden you bear and gives instruction. James 3:13 says "Who among you is wise and understanding? Let him show his good behavior his deeds in the gentleness of wisdom." There are 3 things to notice here. Your wisdom should be shown by your **behavior** and **deeds**, but both of those should be carried out with **gentleness**.

This means that the wisdom you possess (James 1:5 says God gives wisdom generously) needs to be handled with care! It's similar to a horse that has been trained. The horse no longer runs wild but is now turning and obeying its rider. The wisdom you have needs to be in submission to God otherwise you can run into some major problems. The rest of James 3 warns about the evil and disorder that can follow if our wisdom isn't in submission to God.

James 4:6 says, "God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble." In everything we do we need to be in submission to God. His will needs to be our purpose. So, what do you do with that wisdom of yours? Be kind to others both in your behavior and in in your deeds. Be gentle to those around you. Be humble when speaking with others. While you may have all the answers and wisdom, be humble, and in your humility, serve God.
