HOPE IN THE MIDST OF A FOG

Some time back I awoke to a morning that was not only dark and cold, but was also dismal in that a thick blanket of fog enveloped everything around me. It was so thick that you could hardly see five feet in front of me! I found it to be disorienting, frightening, and definitely an anxiety producer as I drove along the streets. But having survived that experience, my curiosity got the best of me, so I decided to find out just how fog was formed. I was somewhat astonished to learn that it is really composed of minute water droplets so small that a billion of them would fill but a single teaspoon!

Have you ever considered how often people live in a "fog" during their sojourn upon Earth? They seem disoriented, anxious, misdirected, and at times, too scared to venture very far emotionally or spiritually from where they are at the moment. What created this fog? Generally, it's the small things, the little episodes, the *what appeared at the time seemed to be a mere inconvenience*, that combined to create confusion and desperation. When the little things unite to crunch the soul, it's no wonder that a person might feel he has the weight of the world on the heart; but do you know what can dispel the fog, clear away the gloomy situation and dread? ***First, one never forgets that hope, when coupled with faith (cf. Heb. 11:1), will act as an agent that can help dispel the fog that seeks to smother our joy.*** Hope reminds us that we have a steadfast Helper who longs to bring us into the clear (cf. 1 Cor. 10:13), and Who possesses a never ending care for our soul (Heb. 13:5,6). ***Second, we can make sure our spiritual headlights are on when the fog seeks to blanket us!*** Physically, when driving in foggy weather, it's wise to always turn on (and keep on) the car's headlights. Likewise, when we let our lights shine spiritually in the midst of a dark society (Phil. 2:14-16), we allow others to know (and hopefully appreciate) that we are near and concerned for their safety (Jude 22,23; Matt. 5:14-16); but more importantly when our lights are shining, it is an indication that we have placed ourselves into the position of spiritual safety due to the fact we are in Christ! ***Finally, we can come out of the fog by making sure we journey with and in the Son!*** Just as the sun disperses the physical fog, the Son of God radiates warmth which shows us the way (Jn. 14:6), provides a penetrating light (Jn. 1:5-9) and removes the loneliness, the fear, and the anxiety that has tried to capture the soul (Matt. 6:19-34; 2 Tim. 1:7; Matt. 28:11-30).

We can try our own methods to bring us into the clear, but in the end, only Christ, the magnificent and unequalled Son, can remove the fog of trial, disappointment, and iniquity!

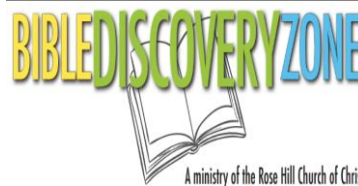
