## Looking Back on 2019

Can you believe that another year has come and gone? Each new year seems to come up more suddenly than we expected. We know, of course, that there are 365/6 days in every year—but it seems like those days go by faster and faster.

Part of the difficulty we face when time seems to rush by us is that we begin to focus only on trying to keep up and hold on. The calendar is filled with family, school, church, and friend related activities—oh, and we have jobs and responsibilities as well! So, we wake up, look at what must be done today, run like crazy to accomplish it all, and wake up the next day to start the process over again.

In the midst of this busyness we rarely have time to look back on our day, week, month, and year for the purpose of thoughtful reflection on what transpired, how it happened, and the reasons things turned out as they did. The problem is that examining the past is an essential part of life—at least life as God designed it.

One of the central blessings of looking back is that it offers us an opportunity to *reprioritize*. I can't help but think of Mary and Martha when Jesus was at their home. Martha was laboring mightily to make sure things were taken care of—cooking, tidying, serving...but Mary? Mary was sitting at Jesus' feet, just listening to him speak. This perplexed Martha greatly. I think it was because she was not able to step back, reflect, and view the bigger picture. Instead, her busyness was blinding her to the importance of prioritization.

So, Jesus spoke to Martha in Luke 10:41-42: "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and troubled about many things, *but one thing is necessary.*"

Jesus wanted Martha to pause and evaluate her priorities rather than be frustrated with her sister. It wasn't that she was doing evil things, it was only that she wasn't focusing on "first things first." If she took the time to do this, she would realize that in this instance Mary was actually choosing to do the most important thing she could do.

We need to spend *much* more time in thoughtful reflection. While I hope you are challenged to find time for this on a regular basis, you also have an opportunity to do so this week. The year 2019 is all but over...take a few minutes to think about what you prioritized during the last year. Have you allowed seemingly *urgent* things to take precedence over that which is *necessary*?
