Lessons from Romans 8

#5 More than Conquerors (8:26-39)

It would be impossible to overstate the richness and depth of this passage of Scripture. Paul, inspired by the Holy Spirit, manages to address the realities of suffering and weakness while also bringing to light the profound hope we have as Christians.

Notice our great neediness. First, we are weak (8:26). Second, we “do not know what to pray for” (8:26). Third, there are sufferings that we endure (implied in 8:28). And fourth, we face opposition of various kinds—from Satan, from persecution, from illness, and much more (8:31-36).

Yet in spite of all of this, Paul declares that we are people who possess a great hope. We are weak, but “*the Spirit helps us in our weakness*” (8:26). We don’t always know the right words to pray, but “*the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words*” (8:26). We face suffering, but “*for those who love God all things work together for good*” (8:28). While opposition may seem scary, Paul asks: “*What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?*” (8:31).

This does not mean that Paul has it in his mind that life will not be challenging or that suffering will simply cease in this life. The apostle Paul went through indescribable suffering for the cause of Christ. He described it like this: “I am being poured out as a drink offering” (2 Tim 4:6). If you wanted an index of many of Paul’s sufferings, he provides that in 2 Corinthians 11:21-29. In v. 23, he addressed those who were doubting his sincerity: “I have worked much harder, been in prison more frequently, been flogged more severely, and have been exposed to death again and again.”

Even in the face of so much pain and suffering, Paul calls us to faith. Why? Because we believe that the Holy Spirit can provide us strength to endure (8:26). We believe that God can take even the most evil situations and bring some good about (8:28). We believe in a God who did not exempt himself from suffering but suffered as one of us (8:32). And we believe that no matter what, God has secured our eternal future through Jesus our Savior.

“In all these things we are *more than conquerors* through him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.” (8:37-39)
