Praise the Lord!

"I will extol you, my God and King, and bless your name forever and ever. Every day I will bless you and praise your name forever and ever. *Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised, and his greatness is unsearchable.*" (Psalm 145:1-3)

If you have spent some time examining the Psalms, you are probably aware that the last five (146-150) all begin with a simple call: "Praise the Lord!" Again, and again, the psalmist calls us to worship and exalt our God and King. While Psalm 145 does not begin with the same call to praise, it certainly deals with a similar theme.

David declares that praising the Lord is something that he cannot help but do on a *daily* basis: "Every day I will bless you." He explains that worshipping God is not something he can imagine doing without: "I will extol you...and bless your name forever and ever." The reason David, in this psalm, is so moved to praise is simple: "Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised, and his greatness is unsearchable."

It is not unusual for us to consider the greatness of the Lord. Like David, we can remember the mighty acts of God (v. 4). We can think about his "mighty and awesome deeds" (v. 6). We can think of God's amazing character, being "gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love" (v. 8). We can even think of God's eternal kingdom (v. 13).

But, just for a moment, I'd like for us to reflect on that final phrase of v. 3: "*his greatness is unsearchable.*" David is not implying that we cannot know God's greatness; rather, God's greatness is a well so deep that we will never be able to get to the bottom. His greatness can never be fully fathomed by us as finite creatures—we can grow in our knowledge of God, but we will never exhaust the possibilities of learning of his greatness.

We could get a small taste of this reality if we simply sat down and began listing all the great things God has done, the great things about God's character, the great things about God's plans, etc. And those are just the things we know about!

I think Psalm 145:3 pairs nicely with Ephesians 3:20-21. As we reflect on this passage, let us begin our morning devoted to answering the great call: *praise the Lord!*

"Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen."
