Lessons from Romans 8

#3 Adopted into the Family (8:15-17)

When you were growing up, how did you picture God?

Perhaps you thought of God as an older man with a white beard who lived up in the clouds and who wasn't particularly interested in your life. Maybe that wasn't your picture at all—maybe your picture of God was of an angry judge who looked down on you, waiting for the moment he could condemn you. Others of you may have thought of God as a kind of cuddly teddy bear that, regardless of how you behaved, wanted to make you feel good. Still others may have grown up believing God was a fairytale that only silly or ignorant people believed in.

We could, of course, continue this list all day. My point is simply that each one of us, myself included, grew up picturing God in one way or another. So did the people who were alive during the time of Jesus, and so did the people who read Paul's letter to the churches at Rome. This morning, I want us to briefly consider how Jesus and Paul present God to Christians—how should we think about God?

When Jesus taught the disciples to pray, his opening statement revealed the primary way that Jesus wanted us to relate to God (Matthew 6:9): "Our Father in heaven..." It shouldn't surprise us to learn that by far the most frequent way Jesus referred to God in the Gospels was as "Father." Jesus wanted us to come into a relationship with God where we would see him as our father and view ourselves as his children!

According to Paul, this relationship is possible because through Christ and through the Holy Spirit we have been *adopted* into God's family. I like the way the NLT puts Romans 8:15, "You have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God's Spirit when he adopted you as his own children."

What an extraordinary thought. We are sons and daughters of the all-powerful, all-knowing, all-loving God of the universe! What an honor. In fact, we are empowered to cry out to God, "Abba! Father!" (Rom 8:15). We get to speak to God as though we were speaking to a loving parent. It makes sense, then, why John would write:

"See what kind of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God; and so, we are." (1 John 3:1)

In Luke 14:16-24 Jesus tells the parable of the dinner. Jesus begins by saying, "A certain man was giving a big dinner, and he invited many; and at the dinner hour he sent his slave to say to those who had been invited, 'Come; for everything is ready now.'"

If you had been invited to a "Big Dinner" and known that this had been planned for a while, would you go? Well, the people that this man invited made excuses and didn't go. One person bought some land and needed to check it out. Another wanted to test his new oxen that he purchased. Another person had just gotten married. One by one they tell why they can't come.

The master who is putting on this big dinner ends up telling his slave, "Go out at once into the streets and lanes of the city and bring in here the poor and crippled and blind and lame." You would think that the dinner would be full of people, but the slave says, "Master, what you commanded has been done, and there is still room." The Master then tells his slave to search everywhere and "compel" the people to come.

You've been invited to dinner by the Lord. The dinner isn't a literal dinner, but it's a life of knowing Jesus and following Jesus. He has extended his invitation to all. Are we too busy today to join Him or do we gladly accept His invitation?
