## Disagreeing With God

Have you ever disagreed with God? Has God ever told you something that made you uneasy? Perhaps it just didn't seem like what was best for you?

If we are reading God's Word regularly, it is not a question of *if* we will find ourselves disagreeing with God but *when*. Scripture, by its very nature, confronts us. It is like a knife that cuts into our heart, revealing our weaknesses and challenging us to be transformed (Heb 4:12). Paul told Timothy that Scripture has the power to, among other things, "correct" (2 Tim 3:16).

It should not be uncommon for God's Word to challenge our assumptions, confront our presuppositions, and call us to alter our convictions, thoughts, and behaviors. In fact, if it seems God's Word *never* disagrees with us we are actually in a dangerous situation! Let me explain.

If God always agrees with me, it really indicates that I am just worshipping a god who is just a bigger version of myself. I am reversing Gen 1:27—I am making a god "in my own image." He supports my causes, he agrees with my decisions, he confirms my convictions—he thinks just like me, says just what I want to hear, and I can always count on him to cheer me on.

The problem with this is that it is an endeavor consumed with *pride*. I make the assumption that all of my conclusions, habits, behaviors, and thoughts are right...then I interpret what God says to back up whatever I already think is right. Can you see the danger in that? Further, it is an endeavor consumed with *idolatry*. I am worshipping a god, but it isn't *the God*. I'm worshipping, frankly, the god of *me*.

While this might seem bleak, I want to offer a word of hope. We are looking at the book of Jonah this morning, particularly Jonah 1:1-4. Jonah had constructed a god in *his* own image, but God graciously exposed Jonah's pride and idolatry. It was not an easy process for Jonah, but God in his love was not going to give Jonah over to these sins without a fight.

The same is true with us. Could it be that God wants to confront the ways we have subtly turned him into just a *bigger you, me, and/or us*? Could it be that God wants to invite us to a new level of faith, a new level of love, and a new level hope? Our prayer is that we would be open to God's confrontation and listen humbly to his call!

### **The Last Straw**

Have you ever been pushed to your limit by someone? Maybe this person bullies you or just knows exactly which buttons to push. How do you handle those situations and treat those that seem to be so against you?

Romans 12 gives us an insight into how we should respond when we are hurt by others. Verse 14 begins this thought by saying, "bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse them." When it would be so typical of this world to turn back to someone and act ugly, we are called to be kind and to bless.

Later in verses 17-18 we read, "Repay no one evil for evil, but give thought to do what is honorable in the sight of all. If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all."

When someone treats us poorly our direct thought may be to get back at them or to say something insulting. Instead of responding that way Paul writes to "give thought to do what is honorable." Instead of quickly reacting, pause, think, and do something honorable.

It's one thing to say, "do something honorable" and we can think of how that would look, but Paul goes on to give some examples. He writes, "if your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink." How will we show the world the love of Christ if we don't treat those around us with love? Jesus set the example by being put to death and in the middle of it He pleads, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."

Paul finishes by writing, "Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good." That's what Jesus did, and that's exactly how we should live our lives.
