The Light of God

Trying to save your eyes from being blinded you decide to make that familiar trek to the bathroom in the dark. You don't need to see; you've made this journey a thousand times. All of a sudden there is an immense pain in your piggy toe that radiates up your leg and into your spine. Yep...you found it...the wall. Now you're even more worked up. Good luck going back to bed after all of this.

Unfortunately, that may be a familiar story to you. You thought it'd be better to walk in the dark and save your eyes and instead you end up hurting yourself even more. That's a pretty similar situation to our spiritual lives.

1 John 1:5-7

"This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin."
