## Sunday, April 26, 2020

### Comforted to Comfort (Part 2)

Whenever I read the four books we call the "Gospels"—Matthew, Mark, Luke and John—I am always amazed by Jesus. No matter how familiar I get with those four accounts, I am constantly encountering new angles and fresh insights. Even more, I am always discovering more about the nature of our Lord.

One of the things I'm always impressed by when I read the Gospels is that it seems like Jesus always knew *just what to say* and *just when to say it*. That doesn't always come easy for me, and I bet you feel the same way!

This week, we are talking about helping others when they are in times of pain and suffering. Sometimes when I'm talking with someone who is facing serious challenges, I wish that I could talk like Jesus by saying exactly what the other person needs to hear.

The bad news is that I am not Jesus—not even close! There are times I say things I wish I would have phrased differently or not said at all. The good news is that over time, by studying Scripture and listening to other's feedback, you and I can refine our speech when comforting someone in need.

I am hoping that someday, once we are all back together again, I'll be able to teach a class or two on this very subject where we can take an in-depth look at how to be best equipped to talk with the hurting. But today, I just want to offer you one thought for your consideration and one thought for your encouragement.

First, I want to challenge you to take an inventory of your "go-to" talking points when someone is hurting. Some people say, "You just need to have faith." Others say, "Let go and let God." And so on. Now, most of these sentences are not factually wrong, but I want you to consider how they might sound from the perspective of someone who is suffering. Sometimes our words end up sounding dismissive of the pain or even as if we are accusing the hurting party of not having enough faith. *We never mean to do this, but our words can sound this way.* When you take your inventory, you might decide to cut out some of those sentences and opt for others—like, "I'm so sorry" or "This is just a terrible situation and I hate that you're having to endure this."

Second, I want to encourage you. The most important thing you can do when someone you love is hurting is to *be there*. Rather than feeling the need to have the perfect line to make them feel better, just be available as a *listening ear* and a *shoulder to cry upon*. There is nothing more important than these two expressions of love.

Remember: we only learn by trying. Not everything will go perfectly, but God has not called us to perfection! He has called us to grow in serving and caring for others. Let's serve according to his call!
