Swords into Plowshares

It shall come to pass in the latter days that the mountain of the house of the Lord shall be established as the highest of the mountains, and shall be lifted above the hills, and all the nations shall flow to it, and many people shall come and say: "Come, let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the house of the God of Jacob, that he may teach us his ways and that we may walk in his paths."

For out of Zion shall go the law, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem. He shall judge between the nations, and shall decide disputes for many peoples; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks; nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore.

O house of Jacob, come, let us walk in the light of the Lord.

(Isaiah 2:1-5)

To read this text is to be in awe of God's vision for his kingdom. On the one hand, Christ has already established this kingdom; yet on the other hand, we are awaiting the *full and final* coming of the kingdom that will take place when Christ returns.

As Christians, our mission is to pursue the kingdom of Christ "on earth as it is in heaven" (Matt 6:10). This means that we seek to better our world by endeavoring to bring it closer to the will of God. We are to "walk in the light of the Lord" as members of "the house of God."

This means, first, that we are ready to be instructed by God: "that he may teach us his ways and that we may walk in his paths." The most important thing I can think to remind you of about God's Word is that we tend to be *selective listeners*. If the word is not confronting us, we are not truly listening!

Secondly, we are willing to proclaim God's will: "out of Zion shall go the law, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem." The Bible is chalk full of communication lessons about how we can bring God's Word to people in a way that they can process and understand.

Third, we are eager to pursue unity: "He shall judge between nations and shall decide disputes for many people." If ever we needed a judge to work for unity in our world it is today! Fortunately, we already know much of our Judge's character and desires. As the church, we can use the "Judge's Word" to help arbitrate disputes.

Finally, we must be active in striving for peace: "they shall beat their swords into plowshares...their spears into pruning hooks." There's a day coming, Isaiah says, in which war will be a thing of the past!

Let us pursue the vision of God for our world, knowing that ultimately, we will see the kingdom in its fullest on the "last day" when Christ comes for his people. Lord, haste the day!

Mike Herndon, a former member and deacon, passed away on Monday from a heart attack. Funeral was on Friday.

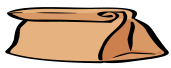
