"You Is What You Eat"

I know the title isn't grammatically correct, but it is a quote from Sylvester Stallone. Years ago, he was interviewed about his strategy for fitness and staying in shape. He talked a bit about the different weight training and cardio plans, but it all came back to that one line: "You is what you eat." His point was that no matter how much you work out, diet plays an integral role in fitness.

To me, that was a bit discouraging! I love to tell myself, "If you will run a mile tonight, you can eat another donut." I have bought into the myth that exercise can "make up" for a bad diet. Of course, it certainly will be better than no exercise at all. But eventually we have to realize that we need a healthy diet in addition to physical exercise.

The spiritual parallels are plentiful. Today, I'm thinking about our spiritual growth. We need healthy spiritual food to fuel our spiritual growth. Without the proper nutrition, we can't see the kind of maturity and growth that God desires for us.

The book of Ezekiel contains an abundance of images, visions, and creative prophecies. It is sort of like Revelation in the Old Testament. But one of the passages that has always stuck with me is in Ezekiel 3:1. God says, "Eat this scroll." And Ezekiel eats it!

I think the point there is Ezekiel is to so internalize God's message that he not only *knows* it, but he also *lives it*. That's true for us too! We need to eat, not a scroll, but *this book*—the Word of God.

The words of the Holy Spirit are sufficient to lead us to spiritual maturity of *thought* and *action*. It isn't so much that we need to try to read vast *quantities* at a time, but rather that we want to so internalize what we read that we *know* it and *live* it. We want to "eat this book"!
