Hidden Blessings

Mao Zedong ("Chairman Mao") issued a nationwide order in 1958 to exterminate four pests in China. The "Four Pests Campaign" was an attempt to eradicate what appeared to be four of the most harmful creatures to Chinese health: mosquitos, flies, rats, and sparrows.

Each of the four creatures brought hardships upon the people: rats, mosquitos, and flies could easily transport disease and get into food supplies; the sparrows could decimate the grain and seed supply that was so crucial to agricultural production.

The Chinese began the project and, by means of advertising campaigns, spurred on the people's efforts to eradicate these pests. They were largely successful in eliminating the sparrows, nearly driving them to extinction in China.

But there was a problem that would soon come to the surface. The sparrows did not merely eat grain and seed...they also consumed all sorts of insects and bugs. In 1960, the Chinese government ended the campaign against sparrows upon realizing that agricultural production had actually been significantly less than what it had been when sparrows were not targeted.

Sadly, it was already too late, and the nation experienced a great famine—compounded by the booming locust population as well as other governmental mismanagements. All in all, it is estimated that as many as 30 million people perished as a result of the famine, making it one of the worst tragedies in history.

The point is that sometimes what appears to be a curse is actually a blessing. The campaign against sparrows seemed like the perfect solution to what appeared to be a national pest that was holding back the prosperity of the country...but it turned out that those sparrows were one of the most ecologically significant members of the natural world and were literally holding China from the brink of famine.

Hindsight is 20/20, as they say. It is easy to criticize now. But haven't we all found things in life that at first appeared to be a nuisance only to turn out to be essential? And moreover, don't we all struggle with complaining and grumbling? What if the things we are annoyed by turn out to be essential—that would certainly change our perspective.

May we give thanks to God, both for the blessings that are easily spotted and for the blessings that remain hidden—blessings that we may never fully appreciate until we see him face to face!


SMALL GROUP BIBLE STUDY
