From the Church Garden

I think it was the apostle Paul who wrote, "Billy planted, Stan watered, but God gave the increase!" Well, perhaps not quite...but something like that!

As I'm writing this, sitting next to me are four cucumbers that came out of the community garden we have here at the church. I can look out my window and see rows of corn, sunflowers, beans, and even some small pumpkins and watermelons. Next time you're here, be sure to walk by and see what you can spot!

Just a couple of months ago the plot of land outside my window was nothing but a dirt patch. Now it is a bountiful garden that is plentiful and providing a great deal of produce every day! Isn't it amazing how God works?

I know, we can recite scientific principles for why good soil + proper watering + proper sunshine/temperature = growth. Those good facts don't change the profound mystery that God designed a tiny seed in such a way that it could spring to such amazing life in a matter of mere days.

The spiritual parallels here are plentiful. But I want you to consider just one. What the apostle Paul really wrote was, "I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase" (1 Cor 3:6).

Paul understood that it was *important* for him to plant the seeds of the gospel message, just as it was *important* for Apollos to water those seeds with further proclamation of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection. But notice what he says in 1 Cor 3:7, the following verse: "So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth."

The bottom line is that no matter how hard our church gardeners worked, it would be pointless without the wisdom and design of God. If seeds weren't made by him to sprout and grow, all the water in the world could not get the job done.

Similarly, when we think about reaching out to others with the gospel it is easy to be intimidated. Just remember: *the power is in the seed, not in the planter!* We can work together to plant seeds, water them, and then we get to watch how God works in people's lives to steer their lives toward him. Of course, each person must decide if they want to follow God...sadly some do not.

But let us strive to eagerly sow the seed, trusting that even if some seeds don't sprout due to hardness of soil (cf. Matt 13:1-23) God will still work to create a vast garden of the redeemed.

Next time you see the garden, consider that we are all like those plants. Our faith started with a small seed, required nutrition, but truly it is only God who is capable of and worthy to receive honor for our spiritual growth and development!


SMALL GROUP BIBLE STUDY
