A 7-Day Challenge: Reclaiming Ownership of Our Screens

My sermon last week described three ways that our screens can be used—and *are being used*—to do great harm to each of us. We can let our screens addict us to distractions, to secret sins, and to our own reflection. I hope some of the statistics I shared resonated with you—perhaps it was even a wakeup call! I know I personally needed to do some introspection about how much I use my screens.

At the same time, you might remember that I began by reiterating that screens, and technology in general, are not inherently bad. This 3-week series was not intended to suggest that in any way—how foolish would we be to use our devices every week creating devos, sermons, emails, articles, and more...only to claim screens should be done away with.

That wasn't the message at all. Are there some real challenges we are facing? Absolutely. Is Scott going to share more of those challenges today as well? Yep.

But screens are only bad if *we allow them to own us* rather than *owning our devices*. While we needed a bit of a wakeup call regarding just how tempting and alluring our screens have become, this series is all leading up to thinking about how we can use our screens in a way that honors God and brings him glory.

That's why we are doing this 7-Day Challenge. We are going on a sort of "phone fast," if you will. Each day is different, and I think each day gets progressively more challenging. But on Saturday we will all have worked our way up to one whole day without our screens.

Now, if you work and your phone is part of your job...we aren't trying to be legalistic about this. Just do your best to *only* use your screens for what is absolutely essential.

But for the rest of us, let's go the whole day...after all, people have gone whole days without screens for...well...thousands of years prior to the 21st century! We can do this!

Why a 7-Day Challenge? Next Sunday, we will talk about how we can use our screens in a positive and healthy way. But before we can do that, we have to own our screens and retake control. So that's why we want to do the 7-Day Challenge—reclaim ownership of our screens and then come to church on Sunday ready to use our phones for God's glory!

I'm excited for this week and I hope you are too!

Looking Beyond Temptation

When was the last time you saw a dessert so delicious looking that your will was just broken, and you had to give in and try it? That pie was just sitting there calling you, "come to me...I'm delicious...you haven't had anything sweet in at least 15 minutes!" You stare and stare and stare until you can't stare anymore. Then you give in. You cut a piece of that pie and oh my goodness it's just delicious...at which point you realize oh no! This pie was filled with toenails! Sick!!

Okay, so that would never happen (I sincerely hope), but temptation works that way. We see something that looks so good and we can't stop thinking about it. We think we want whatever it is that's tempting us and eventually we make a choice. We can choose to resist it, or we can choose to give in. When we resist, we can look back and say, "phew I'm glad I didn't do that!" but when we give in we realize the mistake that we've made. We see that what once looked good is really filled with regret.

How can we handle temptation the way that we are supposed to? How do we resist? We need a God centered mindset. When we see temptation, we need to have a clear view of what God wants for us in that moment. He wants us to escape that temptation (1 Corinthians 10:13), submit to Him (James 4:7), and walk in His light (1 John 1:7).

Only by looking to God first instead of our selfish lusts and desires will we be able to see the toenails in the pie. As gross as that sounds...sin is worse.
