From the Jaws of Death

In June of 2016, a Colorado woman made national news for saving her five-year-old son from a mountain lion attack. The heroic mother had heard her son cry for help when he was outside playing with his brother. Shockingly, when she rushed outside the young mountain lion already had the boy's head in his mouth. As he was dragging her child off, she reached down and was able to pry the cougar's jaws open! The boy, thankfully, survived with only minor injuries.¹

In a sense, this story is shocking—a woman ripped open the jaws of a mountain lion! In another sense, it isn't surprising at all—the love of parents for children will compel them to risk even their own lives in order to rescue the life of their child.

This incredible story is one in a long line of examples that help us better grasp the depth of God's love for us. Like the boy, we have been defeated and nearly consumed by a vicious lion that is prowling around looking to devour humankind (1 Pet 5:8). Indeed, rather than receiving "minor injuries" we were actually "dead in our trespasses and sins" (Eph 2:1).

And yet there came God, rushing out from his heavenly home. From his perspective, he knew precisely what he was doing; but from our humanly perspective, it seemed like he rushed out with reckless abandon. From any vantage point other than God's own, the odds seemed even worse than a woman fighting a cougar. Somehow an uneducated, poor, Jewish thirty-year-old was squaring off against all the forces of evil. Impossible!

On the cross Jesus ripped open the very jaws of death and Hell, liberating his people (Heb 2:14; Rev 20:14). He did not accomplish this by a feat of strength, but rather by a love more powerful than the strongest demonic force—a love so powerful that even the grave was not capable of holding him down.

As we worship God this morning, we have an opportunity to reflect on the tremendous love and mercy of God. He did not leave us to be devoured by Satan and our own devices. Instead, he came to rip open the jaws of evil and set us free from the curse of sin and death. Praise the Lord!

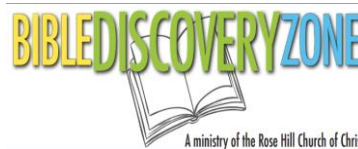
