## Checkmate

I'm not sure if you enjoy the game of chess or not. If you've never played, it's a great game but certainly one that requires practice and focus. It is truly remarkable to see great chess players anticipate one another's moves and develop strategies to conquer their opponent's "king" piece.

But the other day, I was blown away by a video I watched. A man named Magnus Carlsen was playing *three* professionals at one time—that is, each player was sitting at his own chessboard and Magnus was playing three games at once.

Here's the catch: Magnus was *blindfolded!* In chess, each square is numbered with a grid (A1, E5, etc.). So after each opponent would play, someone would announce the move to Magnus: "Knight moves to E3"; "Pawn to A4"; and so forth.

So here this man sat blindfolded, imagining three chessboards and remembering three different series of moves. And he hardly looked phased! He calmly dismantled his opponents, ultimately defeating each in time.

I have to say, I'm not sure if I've seen a more impressive demonstration of "brainpower" than that. It was truly remarkable.

Then I got to thinking. Have you considered the complexity of our world? Think about the billions upon billions of variables that unfold in our universe on a moment-by-moment basis. Think of the complexity of what our cells do in our own bodies every second!

I don't know how many chessboards we would need to make the comparison accurately, but I do know that God has the wisdom to work his will—his "strategy," if you will—even though the level of complexity exceeds trillions of chessboards at once.

I can't sum it up any better than Isaiah does in Isaiah 40:28. He points to God's wisdom as the everlasting, all-knowing, Creator by writing:

"Have you not known? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary; *his understanding is unsearchable.*" (Isaiah 40:28)

Let us praise the Lord whose wisdom transcends our ability to comprehend!

### What Is Your Purpose?

If you were to look around the United States of America, you would see people that seem pretty divided on many issues. This would be even more clear if you watch any amount of news. With an election coming up it's especially clear the divisions that people create. Right or left? Red or Blue? The election isn't the only thing that can divide people but right now it's one of the easiest things to see.

We, being children of God, have a higher purpose than division. We have a purpose of creating unity. Our concern shouldn't be to point people to the right candidate but to point people to the Christ. And the world can speak pretty loudly sometimes. It can be easy to get wrapped up in the concerns of the world. In the things that are divisive. But you, you have been called to unity. You have been called to the body of Christ. That is our mission now. To represent Christ and to see how every single soul needs God. We must move on from the purposes of the world to the purpose of the Kingdom.
