Do Not I Send You?

Gideon was, in his own estimation, a man with very little talent and very little power. He was a weakling, from a weak family, and with no future. He was actually cowering in a winepress "threshing wheat" when God spoke to him.

When God spoke to him through his angel, the message didn't line up with what Gideon felt about himself. God actually called Gideon a "mighty warrior" (Judges 6:12). He also said, "The Lord is with you."

Ordinarily, that might have been a nice compliment and a reassuring promise—I'm mighty and God's with me! Sounds like a good deal... Except Gideon and the nation of Israel had been oppressed by the people of Midian for years. Gideon not only doesn't think he's mighty...he also starts wondering if God is really "with him."

"Pardon me, my lord. But if the Lord is with us, why has all this happened to us?" (6:13).

It's a question we've all asked from time to time. Last Wednesday, we heard a great message about this very question. What happens when things don't seem to go right? Where's God in that?

The reason I love this story is because when Gideon asks the question ("Why?"), God answers with another question. He says, "Go in the strength you have and save Israel...am I not sending you?"

You see Gideon was focused on the reason why bad things had happened. God wanted to get Gideon focused on who God is—his nature and character. He says, "Don't you know that **I** am the one sending you? The God who spoke the world into existence, who split the Red Sea wide open for my people, who brought down manna from heaven, water from rocks, etc.?"

I think there's a powerful lesson there, just like brother Ross taught us on Wednesday. When things go wrong from our perspective, what we most need is not to know the reasons why it happened that way...we most need to know who God is and why he is trustworthy.

That was the lesson Job learned, right? He asked why. There's absolutely *nothing* wrong with that. But he never really got an answer. Instead, God called him to remember his Lord's character and nature—what kind of God he was following.

And when we look to the cross and see our Lord's sacrifice for us, we know that he absolutely loves us. Therefore, even without the reasons we know we can trust him, and we know he can see us through. It won't be easy, but God is with us!

God's Gift During Change

Well it's beginning. School. After a long time of isolation, confusion, and probably sleeping in, school is back in session. Your life is about to face a lot of changes. Your schedule, responsibilities, and social circle are about to be shaken up. While you are able to face the change and you can rise to the challenge of another school year, there is a lesson that you have (most likely) learned over the summer that you shouldn't forget. Rest.

This year forced us to slow down. Something which many of us needed. We can get so caught up in the hustle of life that we forget to rest. We know that when God created the world, He rested on the 7th day. Genesis 2:3 gives a little clearer insight to something that we often overlook, "So **God blessed the seventh day and made it holy**, because on it God rested from all his work that he had done in creation."

He blessed the seventh day and made it holy. The 7th day was made different than all the other days. The seventh day was called the Sabbath, and in Exodus 20:8 God instructs Moses saying, "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy." God wanted His people to rest.

When Jesus was being questioned by the Pharisees about the Sabbath, Jesus tells them in Mark 2:27, "The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath." God made the Sabbath for His people. He set the example of resting so that we would do the same. He wanted the Israelites to keep the Sabbath holy so that they would rest. Today, while we aren't held to the Old Covenant and we don't observe the Sabbath, that concept of rest is a lesson we still need to understand.
