## Plans and Faith

You've probably heard something like this said, "When man makes a plan, God laughs!" The point of that saying has to do with our inability to control the future and God's sovereign power. If there ever was a time where this was clear, it would be now with COVID and the election and so forth.

How many plans were made in the year 2019 about 2020? I can't calculate the figure, but I know that individuals, businesses, organizations, and churches were making plans for another year...and another decade.

So, is it foolish to plan ahead for the future since things can happen that we don't anticipate?

On the one hand, James reminds us of this very lack of control over the future. He urges us not to make our plans in an *absolute* manner, with the presumption that our plans will come out precisely like we plan.

In James 4:13-16 we read, "Come now, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go into such and such a town and spend a year there and trade and make a profit'—yet you do not know what tomorrow will bring. What is your life? For you are a mist that appears for a little time and then vanishes. Instead, you ought to say, 'If the Lord wills, we will live and do this or that.' As it is, you boast in your arrogance. All such boasting is evil."

But notice that nowhere does James suggest that the actual act of *planning* is arrogant—only the notion that we can somehow guarantee our plans will come to pass on our schedule.

Planning itself is viewed as a blessing, even as an *essential* task. Solomon wrote in Proverbs 21:5, "The plans of the diligent lead surely to abundance, but everyone who is hasty comes only to poverty."

Taken together, James and Solomon help us understand that planning is something that we should do *in conjunction with* prayer and faith in God. Importantly, we believe that God can be just as much at work in our *plans* as he is in times of crisis.

Even when our plans fail, the act of planning helps prepare us for the future. On the one hand, it helps us because we are considering things that may happen in the future and preparing for them. On the other hand, it helps us because once we have a plan we can *adapt to the situation*. With no plan whatsoever we would be, to borrow the Biblical metaphor, "tossed to and fro by the waves."

So, invite God into the planning process, and trust that he will help you adapt the plan to meet the situation when crisis comes upon you.

"The heart of man plans his way, but the Lord establishes his steps." (Prov 16:9)

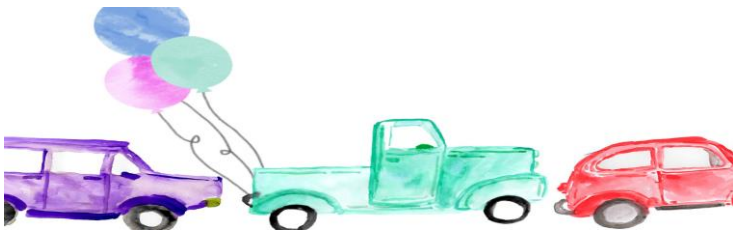
