Led by the Spirit

If you read the Harry Potter books (or seen the movies), you might remember that the first book is all about a mysterious, powerful "sorcerer's stone." Supposedly, the stone would sustain a person's life for centuries and would bring all sorts of prosperity to the person who had it.

Clearly, an item of that much power could be a great threat if it fell into the wrong hands. Without rehashing the whole story, in the struggle to prevent the stone from getting into the wrong hands there is a decision made to destroy the stone forever.

This, sadly, meant that the creator of the stone—who had been relying on its life-giving properties for centuries—would perish. But he was willing to die at last in order to save the world.

Harry, a young boy, asked Dumbledore, a wise wizard, about this decision. He responded, "You know, the Stone was really not such a wonderful thing. As much money and life as you could want! The two things most human beings would choose above all...*the trouble is, humans do have a knack of choosing precisely those things that are worst for them.*"

He's not wrong, is he? We have a long history—individually and collectively—of making the wrong choices for ourselves. Left to our own devices we would consistently choose things like power, pleasure, possessions, and more. Yet, in the end, each of these things can rob our soul and eventually drive us to despair.

Long before J. K. Rowling, the apostle Paul urged the world to be "led by the Spirit" (Rom 8:14; Gal 5:18). Instead of allowing our desires to do the leading, Paul was pleading that we might allow God's Spirit to be our guide and guardian.

Even when we want to do the right thing, we still struggle to do it. In Galatians 5:17, Paul says:

"For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do."

We need help in our struggle against "the flesh" (that is, our evil-prone longings). The only way we can begin to overcome is explained in verse 16: "Walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh."

This is a process and it takes time. But I truly believe the first step is to honestly admit that we are incapable of leading ourselves well. Otherwise, we will "walk by the Spirit" selectively—a recipe for disaster. It takes courage to admit our weaknesses, but in our weakness God's power is displayed most (2 Cor 12:9)!
