A Debtor to All

As we consider the reasons that many reject the message of the cross in 1 Cor 1:18-25, we have seen that the "religious" folks have their reasons and we will explore today the reasons "secular" people have. As we do so, I want to mention a great parallel passage: Romans 1:14-17. Paul says,

"I am a debtor both to Greeks and to barbarians, both to the wise and to the ignorant. So I am eager to preach the gospel to you also who are in Rome. For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."

Now, there's a lot more here than I can discuss in this short article. But I want you to notice a couple of things today.

First, note that Paul is well aware of the fact that many will view the gospel as "foolish." He embraces the simplicity of the gospel, saying "I am not ashamed of the gospel." Just because the religious are offended by the depth of grace and the secular mock, Paul determines that he will keep on speaking the good news.

Second, Paul keeps speaking what seems foolish to the world because he knows that it is really "the power of God for salvation to all who believe." It was because Paul had completely embraced the reality of the gospel's true *power* that he was able to find incredible *courage*. His boldness in spreading the message was built upon his confidence that the message was worth spreading!

Finally, Paul did not discriminate in announcing the message of the cross. Whether secular or religious, wise or foolish, well-behaved or unruly: Paul had a message for all people.

Sadly, there were times when Paul *did* have to walk away from people. Typically, it was the "religious people" who couldn't embrace his scandalous message (e.g., Acts 18:6). But it was not after first sharing with them the great message of Jesus Christ. In the same way, we must root ourselves deeply in faith that the cross is the power of salvation...and though some may refuse it, we have an opportunity to partner with God in changing lives and changing the world!

We live in a world that is constantly changing. Half the congregation is having babies, America is having an election, and Walmart is buying tik tok. There is something new every single day. Not only that but so many ideas are changing as well. Things that were held as truth and fact are now looked over as personal preference. While it's good to reflect and look on what we believe, we also need to be careful about what ideas we are letting in.

Paul was concerned about this in his day as well. In Colossians 2:8 Paul writes, *"See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the world, and not according to Christ."* Be careful with the ideas and movements that culture pushes on you. The world can be very convincing and deceptive, but don't be fooled, Christ is the answer. Christ will always be the answer.

The things we read in the Bible are solid and true. God does not change even in a world that constantly is changing. That means what we read in the Bible, what is God-Breathed, doesn't change.

How do we stay constant and confident in the word of God? In the verses just before Paul's warning he gives a good encouragement, "Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving."

Be rooted in Christ, walk in that faith, continue to grow in him, and be constant in thanksgiving. In a world that is constantly changing we must hold onto and place our roots in our God who does not change.
