## Yes, It Has To Be Done More Than Once!

I had put IT off for as long as I could, but when I heard my neighbor's lawnmower start and saw her in her yard, I knew it was time for me to mow my lawn. Mowing the lawn has never been one of my favorite Spring and Summer (and Fall in Georgia) things to do because I realize there's a lot more to the process than just cutting the grass. Once you do that, there's a cascading effect of having to edge and trim. I often put off the jobs until I have little choice or until I'm "shamed" into getting out the tools and working!

Shortly after I mowed the yard the first time, I started looking at the state of the grass itself. Oh, it was green, but I couldn't help but notice that a lot of the color was in the form of weeds, crab grass, and other undesirable vegetation. Had I not procrastinated in cutting the lawn, I probably would have caught the problem earlier and thus would have taken the proper measures to eradicate the weeds. I learned that **bad things don't go away by themselves and that if I wanted the "good", I needed to be proactive and attend immediately to the problem.** It's the same way spiritually. If we would stave off trial or minimize the effects of a hardship, we likewise need to be proactive, not putting off confronting the "weeds" until they have taken over our hearts, souls, and minds. Failure to respond right away to a spiritual threat can lead to our souls being captured by the very thing we hate or dread!

A second lesson my procrastination taught me was that **there is instant gratification and emotional pleasure in completing a job and doing it well.** Once I finished the mowing, trimming, and edging of the yard, I felt immediate satisfaction in having brought order and beauty to the landscape. Spiritually speaking, if we will, by faith (Heb. 11:6), take the "bull by horns" when it seeks to gore us with trial, bitterness, disappointment, and temptation, we will experience a sense of triumph, completeness, and yes, satisfaction in having fought and faced the foe in the right way (Rom. 5:1-5; Jas. 1:2-4)!

A final thing **I learned is that I can't mow the yard one time and expect it to stay short or that the grass along the curb will never need trimming again.** For as long as the season(s) lasts, things will continue to grow, especially the weeds and undesirable vegetation. It's the same way with trials and hardships. It is because our adversaries are determined to get us off course that we need to stand ever vigilant and continually alert to the efforts and strategies of those who would pervert our way (1 Pet. 5:8,9). Just because we might have defeated our enemies once doesn't mean that we never will have to fight again.

### **A Changed Life**

Do you ever wonder what people are thinking about you? How would you feel if you were a complete outcast? Not just a few people disregarding you, but almost everyone you know. How would you handle that?

In Luke 19 we see this play out. We see a man who is an outcast even when he is surrounded by people. What's more interesting is that he is exactly who Jesus wants to see. The man is Zacchaeus the chief tax collector. Jesus is passing through the town of Jericho and He has a crowd following Him. Zacchaeus desperately wants to see Jesus, but he can't see around the crowd. He runs up ahead, climbs up a tree, and waits. When Jesus passes by He calls Him down, "Zacchaeus, hurry and come down, for I must stay at your house today."

Jesus sees the outcast and chooses him. The person who is the most unloved is now the host to the Son of God.

Jesus is constantly challenging our view of who to love and what that looks like. Jesus chooses the chief tax collector. Zacchaeus was an easy guy to hate. He's a Jewish man collecting taxes from Jewish people for the Roman Empire. Yet Jesus sees through the crowd of people and calls Zacchaeus. Jesus knew that Zacchaeus' heart was ready to be changed.

Zacchaeus decides to repay the people he's wronged and to give half of his goods to the poor. How do you let Jesus change your life? Jesus challenges us to change and grow, but also to love people the way He did. Through our love and our actions this world will know that Jesus saves lives and changes them.
