“And Also Much Cattle”

Would it surprise you to learn that this is the last phrase in the book of Jonah in the Bible? It surprised me when I first stopped to think about it! Let's refresh ourselves on the context, quickly:

When Jonah refused to answer God's call to preach to Nineveh, he ran away and found himself in the belly of a great sea creature. Eventually, he admitted his stubbornness and the fish spat him out on dry land to go to the city and preach. When the people repented, Jonah was very angry with God for being gracious! God decided to teach Jonah an object lesson with a plant that he caused to grow, providing Jonah with shade, and then it withered before his eyes. Jonah was even more angry!

God asked Jonah a simple question: *“Do you do well to be angry about the plant?”* (4:9) God goes further, and this is how the book of Jonah ends. He asks him:

“You pity the plant, for which you did not labor, nor did you make it grow, which came into being in a night and perished in a night. And should not I pity Nineveh, that great city, in which there are more than 120,000 persons who do not know their right hand from their left, and also much cattle?” (4:10-11)

Now, there's a great lesson there about forgiveness and the hypocrisy of our anger. But that's not what I want to think about right now. I want to think about that last phrase: *and also much cattle.*

Do you think that God cares about his creation, which he designed and created by his own power and from his own will? Here, God is concerned primarily about the people of Nineveh who he will soon destroy if they do not repent...but he's *also* concerned about the welfare of the cattle that also occupied the city.

God takes no pleasure in the death of any part of his creation. It may be necessary for us to take the life of animals in order to eat and be clothed, but that is not the way the world worked back in the Garden of Eden. It is necessary in our fallen world, but it wasn't necessary in God's *perfect* world.

I know I need to remember to look at the natural world around me with more respect and appreciation—there's not a single thing I'll see in the world today that God isn't responsible for creating! Let's take a moment to rejoice in the wisdom and beauty of nature that reflects the beauty and wisdom of its Creator.

A Mind of Worship

In Matthew 21 we read a familiar passage where Jesus enters into the temple and he sees people buying and selling things. What does He do? He drives them out. He turned over the tables and drove them out. We hear this passage, and we hear lessons about righteous anger. What we don't typically hear about is what happens immediately after this.

Right after he drives these people out of the temple, we see in verse 14, "And the blind and the lame came to Him in the temple, and He healed them." In only a few moments, the temple has gone through a massive change. It was filled with people buying and selling things, people filled with greed. Now it's filled with people filled with hope. People who were hurting who came to be healed.

There were people there interested in only taking care of themselves. Filling their pockets. They were there with selfish ambition. Jesus didn't want any of that. He changed it to a place where people who needed help could go and find healing. He welcomed those who were lacking something. Jesus was there to take care of those in need.

When we come to worship God, we come to be healed, encouraged, taught, and loved. When Jesus drives out those who were buying and selling things He says, "It is written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer;' but you are making it a robbers' den." He was making the temple a house of prayer. A place to commune with God. A place to connect with God.

The building we worship in is just that, a building. But when worship God, we are doing something very special. We are communing and connecting to God. We come to God realizing that we need Him, and only Him.
