Humility

You would have never guessed it if you had met them. From the way they talked, they owned a few acres of land and worked to make a living raising cattle. The husband would get up and start working early in the morning, and when he left the house his wife would pack up and go to the school to work as a teacher's assistant.

They were ordinary people. They came to church every week in ordinary clothes, they drove ordinary cars, they lived in an ordinary house. They volunteered their time serving the church, they loved their children deeply, liked to talk about college football.

Maybe it would surprise you to know that they actually owned one of the biggest ranches in their county, with hundreds of acres of land and a net worth of millions!

You wouldn't have guessed it if you had met her, either. She was a schoolteacher all her life, never married, and lived by herself. Her apartment was modest, furniture had been used for years, and you might presume that she had to keep to a pretty strict budget. She wasn't interested in driving luxurious cars or wearing fancy clothes. Every now and then she would go on a vacation somewhere, but never for very long.

Does it surprise you that she gave *a few million dollars* to her local church on the day of her passing?

The point of these illustrations is simple: these people lived out their lives in such a way that they were not defined by their earthly status. When you met them, they didn't let you know that they were wealthy. They didn't explain how powerful they were in their communities or how important their contributions to society were.

Instead, they were people who took a genuine interest in talking with *you* when you were with them. They weren't even considering their own image; they were just living out life in a way they believed would honor God.

That reminds me of what Peter said in 1 Peter 5:5,

"Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for 'God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.'"
