At Your Service

During the Middle Ages, many nobles and rulers appointed great warriors to be "knights." These knights were often expected to hold to a certain code of conduct—they were to be "chivalrous." This primarily meant that they were to be courageous in the face of battle, to conduct themselves as professionals, and sometimes included treating the "common people" with some measure of respect.

You've probably seen someone "knighted" before on TV since the practice technically still exists. But rather than a political statement or honor bestowed by modern kings and queens, imagine the scene from back in these ancient times:

In walks a large man who towers over most people in the room. He's covered in armor and his boots thunk loudly as he enters in the great hall. Strapped to his side is a sword that glimmers in the lamp-lit room. Perhaps he has a shield strapped to his back, bearing his family sign or the sign of the king who sits before him. Underneath his arm he carries his helmet; although it is polished up, you can still see dents that bring memories of battles fought and pain endured.

This heroic figure approaches the enthroned ruler, bows on his knee, and holds up his sword to the king. The king approaches him, grasping the knight's sword and raising it up. He softly runs his hand along the blade and feels its sharpness. All of the sudden, he places it on the knight's shoulder. With one thrust to the side, this mighty man would be reduced to nothing! But instead, the king simply moves the sword to his other shoulder and declares him a knight. This establishes the man as a warrior on the king's behalf and in the king's service.

There's a particular aspect of this scene I want you to consider. In order to become a knight, this warrior must bow before the king and hand over his sword. He has to assume a position of complete vulnerability. In order to be knighted, this man communicates to the king: "I am completely at your service. I am forfeiting my right to life—my life is now in your hands."

In the context of that world, that would have to be a considerably frightening and dangerous thing to do. But in the context of our faith, we are really called to do the same before the throne of God. We have to be willing to admit that our "strength" is not adequate and that our true loyalty lies with the King of Kings rather than with our sword. We have to allow our lives to be so given over to God that we could say that our life and devotion are in His hands!

"Only fear the Lord and serve him faithfully with all your heart. For consider what great things he has done for you." (1 Samuel 12:24)

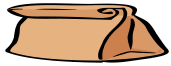


PARTNERS 4 AFRICA

Walking with Integrity

We talked a good bit on Wednesday about integrity and the lack thereof. How David was a man of integrity, but the time that he let his guard down, his world got a lot messier. He did everything in his power to cover up his sin with Bathsheba which led him to murder. When we make the decision to step away from walking with integrity, we can end up in a world of hurt and messiness. Solomon, David's son, knew this (not that he was perfect either) and he wrote about the importance of integrity on multiple occasions.

Proverbs 10:9

Whoever walks with integrity walks securely, but he who makes his way crooked will be found out.

Proverbs 11:3

The integrity of the upright guides them, but the crookedness of the treacherous destroys them.

Proverbs 28:6

Better is a poor man who walks in his integrity than a rich man who is crooked in his ways.

Solomon places a profound importance on walking with integrity. He warns that our evil deeds will be found out and destruction will follow. He also mentions how the worlds riches aren't worth anything if we aren't walking with integrity.

So, what does it look like to walk with integrity? Well, our life is to be seasoned by the Word of God and our actions are to be shaped by Christ. Why is this so important? 1 John 1:7 gives us plenty of motivation. John writes "If we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin."

Fellowship and forgiveness. Those are two priceless gifts that God gives us. May your week be filled with integrity and may others see the love of Christ through what you say and do.
