Check Your Boots

Our church is blessed to have so many veterans as part of our family, and we are certainly thankful for each of them and their presence. One of the movies I have seen that made me appreciate this service very deeply was *We Were Soldiers* (2002). It's a brutal movie that depicts the horrific struggle of war and the pain of loss. Yes, we are thankful for those who have put themselves in harm's way for our sake!

There is a scene in this movie, though, that stands out to me and teaches a powerful lesson about leadership and building one another up. It fits perfectly with the idea of this morning's sermon about the importance of having meaningful Christian relationships.

In the movie, Colonel Hal Moore and Sergeant Major Basil Plumley are watching a group of young soldier's train to engage in the battle that is to come. In particular, they are watching the leadership techniques of the lieutenants. Something stands out to Colonel Moore when Second Lieutenant Jack Geoghegan commands his men to come to a halt and take off their boots.

Geoghegan had noticed that one of his men, Private First-Class Willie Godbolt, was grimacing and inferred that it was from blistering. So he had everyone take off their boots and check one another's feet for blisters. He instructed Godbolt to get new socks from supply and to keep his feet dusted with powder.

Colonel Moore, watching intently, said to the Sergeant Major: "Now, that man is a leader!"

But there's another dimension to this story that I haven't even mentioned. Geoghegan was a white man and Godbolt was a black man. This was in the 1960s, when racial tensions and civil rights battles were at the forefront of society. Here is a white man who has stopped to hold a black man's foot in his hands, examine his wounds, and ordered his men to treat one another in the same way!

To me, there is a lot of power in that scene. First, it reminds me of the kind of leadership Jesus demonstrated in John 13 when he washed the disciples' feet. He was a servant-leader, filled with humility and working for other's interests rather than seeking his own (cf. Phil 2:5-11).

But it also reminds me of how we should relate to one another as Christian family. Each of us has the opportunity to connect with a few Christian friends in such a way that we might learn one another's struggles, examine each other's wounds, and help one another heal as we journey through life. We don't do it because it is comfortable or give credence to societal pressures...we do it because it is both *right* and *meaningful*.

"Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ." (Gal 6:2)

Dealing with Conflict

When is the last time you were in an argument? How did it start? What was it about? How did the conflict make you feel? We aren't strangers to conflict and sadly many times we don't handle it properly.

There are so many things that we care about and we can be passionate about. We need to be careful that our passion doesn't turn into arrogance or anger. When we hear a different opinion or belief it can be easy to jump to fight. We often label the other person without knowing their full position or belief.

How do we properly handle those situations when we come to a conflict? What's the best thing to do? Stand up tall and argue louder? Don't say anything? What's truly best?

James gives us all some fantastic advice when he writes "Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger." When we come to a discussion, we should respect the other person regardless of their viewpoint (because they are also loved by God) and hear them out. Listen to what they say. Practice patience and learn the art of being quiet. Then share what you have to say. Not in an anger, but in love.

Just because we may disagree about something doesn't mean we are allowed to act ugly to each other. Instead, that is the perfect time to show our love to each other. At that time, we put Matthew 22:39 into practice where we love our neighbor as ourselves. We embody Philippians 2:3 where we regard each other as more important than ourselves.

How do we deal with conflict? We love each other and we are patient with each other. We hear each other out and speak in love.
