## Out For The Season

You may have seen on the news last week that Joe Burrow suffered from a horrific leg injury during the Cincinnati Bengals game against the Washington Football Team. You don't have to like the Bengals to feel for their quarterback—his ACL was torn, and they are still doing more diagnostic tests at the time I'm writing this.

I'm sure it seemed like any other play for the 2019 Heisman winner out of LSU. He dropped back in the pocket near his own goal line. He threw the ball deep, but as he did so he was sacked. And as he was sacked, his knee suffered greatly.

The news sources are already saying that Joe is out for the season—maybe longer. He will have an excruciating road to recovery, and who is to say how agile he will be in the future if/when he is able to return to play?

That got me thinking. There are a lot of times in my life and your life in which we forget that life can change quickly, and we can find ourselves "out for the season." This year has been the most poignant reminder of that fact in a long time—it seems like we've all been "out for the year" in many ways.

One thing I hope to take with me as we transition out of 2020, hopefully leaving behind some of its woes, is that reminder of how quickly things beyond our control can change our plans for life.

We should always be diligent planners, be hard workers, and do our best to manage the health, time, and resources God has entrusted us with. But it is easy to forget James' word of caution in James 4:13-16:

"Now listen, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money.' Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. Instead, you ought to say, 'If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that.' As it is, you boast in your arrogant schemes. All such boasting is evil."

James is not attempting to make us "superstitious," as though saying the phrase "if the Lord wills" is a magic formula to make sure we get what we want. Rather, James is teaching us that we need to cultivate a heart of dependency upon God during the planning phases of life. We need to remember that the fundamental need we have is God's presence in our lives—if we have to change plans it will be okay as long as we have God by our side.

Let us not presume on our own strength or wisdom but may we each depend fully on the Lord's presence as we navigate the good times and the "out for the season" times of life!
