It doesn't Make Sense

Did you know it was against the law in North Carolina to *plow your field with an elephant*? I would love to know exactly why a group of legislators at some point in time found it necessary to pass such a statute, but I'm sure there was some type of rationale motivating their action. Now even though I may never understand why the law was passed or even agree with the explanation given to make the legislation a law, one point is clear: *I don't have to agree with the rationalization or even the ordinance itself for it to be valid!*

There are a lot of things in life I don't comprehend. For example, how is it possible that an ugly caterpillar can enter into an unsightly cocoon and emerge a beautiful, multicolored, graceful in flight, butterfly? You see, I don't have to know or understand how such a "wonder" occurs in order for it to be true; no amount denial will change the reality of the "phenomenon".

There are a great many people in our world today who are absolutely convinced that the act of *prayer* is little more than a useless petition made to a nonexistent god by a superstitious individual who is desperate to believe something because he lacks the courage to face the realities of life! To the atheist, agnostic, and pseudo-believer (cf. 2 Tim. 3:5), prayer is just make-believe, pure foolishness, and an exercise that lacks any comprehensive rationale.

But what about the attitude of those who believe in God's existence and power? Are they **FULLY** convinced that when they approach the throne of God that they are always heard? Often times, those who petition the Father do so with a mentality that cripples their faith due to the fact they feel that all requests, all questions, and all needs aren't answered and fulfilled as they desire or in the time frame, they have set. When such occurs, there may be a tendency for a soul to question Jehovah's rationale and commitment to helping His children develop a full sense of peace (cf. Phil. 4:4-7). Of course, when such doubts descend upon the heart, faith needs to increase, and faith tells us that we don't have to know how God answers prayer, or the reasons as to why some answers are "yes", some are "no" and why some are "not now" (Deut. 29:29)! Faith leads us to unflinchingly accept as true (though we may not see the immediate results) the promise that the "effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much" (Jas. 5:16).

The skeptic will always ask "why" and declare, "Show me the evidence, rationale, and reason before I believe", especially when it comes to prayer, but a Christian proclaims, "*Faith has already shown me the evidence as to the reality of prayer, so I don't need to understand how God works- only that He does!*"
