### **Rich Living**

There is a lot of importance placed on having money. You see it everywhere, people trying to strike it rich. If you don't think so, then just turn on the TV and you'll see a million game shows where people are trying to win as much money as possible. If we aren't careful, we may end up getting swept up into that mindset.

When you think about what it means to be rich, it really means to have an abundance of something. In Colossians, Paul tells us where we are to abundant, more specifically what is to be abundant within us. Colossians 3:16 says, "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly." There is an importance place on us being rich in this world, but the truth is that Christ needs to be rich within us. We are to be abundant with the word of Christ.
