I Didn't Expect That!

Expectations. They are kind of like opinions...everyone has them. We have expectations for how people should drive, what people should wear, how our boss should treat us, what the future will hold, and more. But there's one relationship in most people's lives that is characterized by expectations: *marriage*.

We bring expectations into our marriages of all sorts and sizes. We have expectations about which partner will do what tasks, how decisions will be made, parenting styles, future goals as a couple, conflict resolution, sex, and romance, and that just scratches the surface!

The problem, of course, is that no couple—no matter how much they thought they were a "perfect match"—enters a marriage with identical expectations. What makes matters worse is that neither spouse fully knows *their own expectations*! We are all a combination of conscious and unconscious expectations, and when those expectations differ with our spouse's, conflict is likely just around the corner.

In an excellent book on marriage called *Fighting for Your Marriage* (2010), three marriage counseling experts share four things every married couple can do to help navigate their expectations. I'm going to list a Bible verse that corresponds to each of these principles and encourage you to look each reference up!

1. Being aware of what you expect. This means being honest with yourself, evaluating and examining your expectations...this is not easy! (2 Corinthians 13:5)
2. Being reasonable in what you expect. Just being aware of an expectation does not make it a good expectation! We have to evaluate our expectations and then throw out those expectations that are either unhelpful or even sinful (Lamentations 3:40)
3. Being clear about what you expect. It doesn't help our spouse when we don't communicate our expectations. No one is all-knowing except God. If you don't clearly state your expectations, it is unreasonable to assume that your spouse will guess them (Proverbs 27:5-6)
4. Being motivated to meet the other's expectation, even when you don't have the same expectations. To love our spouse well does not mean that we have to be in full agreement on every minor detail of life—what it does mean is *sacrificing*: putting our spouse's interests beyond our own (Phil 2:4).

When two people are committed to pursuing one another for a lifetime of love, marriage becomes a beautiful gift from God. Spend some time considering your expectations and working together as a couple to further your connection and grow closer to one another!
