Jesus Saves

In Matthew 9:18-26, we find Jesus on his way to resurrect a ruler's daughter. Now, that's a pretty important thing—wouldn't you say? Jesus is setting off down the road to go to this poor father's house, no doubt listening to sobs and anxious chatter along the way. If ever there was a time to avoid distractions, this would be it! Surely Jesus would want to get there straightaway!

But the passage continues, and we discover that a suffering woman of great faith came to Jesus...well, she sort of "snuck up" to Jesus and touched the hem of his garment. Jesus tells the woman, "Take heart, daughter, your faith has made you well."

Now, if we keep reading, we find that Jesus does raise the girl (v. 25). But I want you to stop and think about what Jesus says to the woman who touches his garment: "Your faith has *made you well*."

A preacher once gave a sermon called "Jesus Saves" based on this very passage. The term "made well" is the same word that is elsewhere translated as "saved." English translators will make a decision based on context to help clarify the meaning, as they should, and so whenever it seems to refer to physical healing they will say "made well" vs. if it seems to refer to spiritual healing then they will say "saved."

Now, this preacher was well aware of the validity of this translation process—after all, there is a difference between being saved from a physical and spiritual ailment. And yet he wanted to call attention to the fact that the New Testament describes "salvation" in broader terms than we often do. The term refers to more than just what happens inside your soul, it has to do with things being "put right"—it has to do with "the restoration of all things" (Acts 3:21).

This is important because it helps us better understand our mission as Christians. We are called to work toward "saving" the lost from sin; at the same time, we are also called to help meet others' needs in order to help "save" them from the *consequences* of sin in our world (poverty, loneliness, addiction, grief, etc.).

When the woman that touched Jesus was "made well," I would be willing to bet that she would have told her friends and family, "Jesus saves!" In the same way, when we help people with their needs as representatives of Christ the goal is that they will also be able to say, "Jesus saves!"

As the preacher said, "You can call it being 'made well' if you want to...but Jesus *saves!*" Praise God that we follow a Savior who has saved our souls but is also leading us to a future in which we have redeemed bodies and are free from the hardships of this life. Jesus saves!

Teach Me

Who is your favorite teacher at school and what subject do they teach? What makes them stand out above your other teachers? Is it the subject that you enjoy, the way they teach, or a mixture of the two? Whoever it may be, you find yourself waiting in anticipation for that class. You are probably in your least favorite class right before it, and all you want is for the bell to ring (or zoom class to end). You think to yourself, "If I can just make it through this one class then I get to go to my favorite one."

When you read through Psalm 25 you see a similar attitude expressed from David. He just wants to sit God's feet and learn from Him. He wants the ways of God to be set on his own heart. Psalm 25:4-5 says, "Make me to know your ways, O LORD; teach me your paths. Lead me in your truth and teach me, for you are the God of my salvation; for you I wait all the day long."

In the following verses he asks God to forgive him of his past wrongs and to have mercy on him. He realizes his errors and wants to God to instruct him in how he should live.

This is a beautiful lesson we can learn from David. We fall short so often and instead of desiring to follow sin we should desire God and a life that reflects His holiness. May we truly desire to sit at the feet of God and learn everything He has to teach.
