Ancient Words

The other day I was reflecting on a hymn that you might have heard called "Ancient Words." The lyrics call us to consider the power of the words of Scripture, not because they are "ancient" but because they are "living and active" (Heb 4:12).

The chorus of the song stood out to me last week:

*"Ancient words, ever true,
changing me and changing you.
We have come with open hearts, O let the ancient words impart!"*

Last week we discussed how reading Scripture is most effective when we let Scripture read us—i.e., when we let God's Word reveal who we are in comparison to Jesus. The more clearly, we see Jesus, the more clearly, we realize our own inadequacies and need for grace; moreover, we see that we need God to transform our life!

I like this song because it expresses that very sentiment and makes us ponder it when we gather together for worship.

We have come together today in large part to listen to the Scriptures because we believe those "ancient words" are "ever true." They are God-breathed, inspired words that the Holy Spirit has prepared for us through human authors (2 Tim 3:16; 2 Pet 1:16–21). And so we are here because we want to hear the *truth* from God's Word.

We have also come because the "ancient words" have more than just truth...they contain *power to change*. As an assembly, we are filled with imperfection. And yet we can also look at ourselves and our Christian family and realize that God is making progress in His people. He is "changing me and changing you," and one of the ways he does this is through the Scriptures (John 17:17).

Finally, we have come because we are *ready to receive* these words of power and truth contained in Scripture. My prayer is that my heart and your hearts are open and eager to "receive the implanted word" (James 1:21). Like I said, we are imperfect people. But we have come to the same conclusion as Peter came to in John 6:68: "Lord, to whom shall we go? *You have the words of eternal life...*"

So, as we prepare to worship let us come with this earnest plea: "O, let the ancient words impart!"

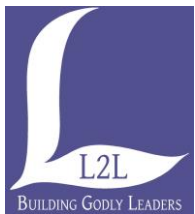
