What Do I Know?

When I was a freshman at Freed-Hardeman, I was surprised to find myself as the new "preacher" of a small country church in rural Tennessee. When I say "preacher," I mean I was responsible for preaching and teaching three lessons on Sunday; the rest of my week was spent at school and the church was quite a drive, so I was unable to do much more than that.

Immediately I felt the weight of being young. I didn't have my education completed, I didn't have a wealth of personal experiences, and I had little idea about the culture of Middle Tennessee.

As I planned out my sermon topics for the semester, I would try to think of topics that were relevant and biblical. In the course of making those plans, I would inevitably come to the subject of *marriage*.

For the first year or so, I didn't touch the subject. Frankly, I was afraid of it. I was an unmarried 18-year-old college student speaking before a group of married couples who had been married for decades...one couple had even been married for 75 years!

But then I read something that made me realize that I was being spiritually immature. I was pretending that the wisdom in preaching was supposed to be *mine*, instead of God's! I was worried about what *I* knew rather than what *God* knew about marriage.

Now, don't get the wrong picture. I didn't waltz into church the next Sunday with a sermon called "100 ways your marriages are failures." I tried to simply speak with humility, acknowledging all I don't know and praising God for all he does know about the ever-important subject of marriage.

That brings me to last week's message, as well as this week's message. I'll be the first person to admit to you that there's a lot about marriage that I have far less knowledge about than many of you who have been married for decades and decades. I hope it is evident that my ambition is not to give you advice because of "how smart I am" or "how good my marriage is compared to yours."

If there's one lesson I've learned from listening to people with long-lasting, God-centered marriages it is this: *the only true marriage expert is God*. He's the designer of marriage, the center of healthy marriages, the healer of broken marriages—God is the only expert. Certainly not Nathan Diller!

Today, as we worship God and reflect on marriage, know simply this: *only Jesus* can help us navigate our relationships in the best way possible. My message today will not be worth listening to if it is just marital advice from Nathan. Yet, if we *humbly focus on God's Word about marriage*, we truly can grow in our relationship with our spouse and with the Lord!

What Are You Training For?

We are wrapping up the month of January and taking a step into February. That means if you made a new year's resolution then it's probably time to start doing it. For many people they set the resolution of better health or getting into shape. This requires self-discipline to make yourself train. In 1st Timothy 4, Paul even writes about how physical training has benefits. While you may have physical personal goals, remember your spiritual goals for this year.

Yes, in 1 Timothy Paul talks about physical training, but it's only to highlight the importance of spiritual training. 1 Timothy 4:7-8 says, "Have nothing to do with irreverent, silly myths. Rather train yourself for godliness; for while bodily training is of some value, godliness is of value in every way, as holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come." He says that training yourself spiritually, for godliness, is vitally important. Meaning, you should be training yourself on a regular basis.

That's all fine and good, but how do you train spiritually? To train your body you go to the gym, workout, and eat the right things. Then eventually you see the growth and improvement. Training spiritually is no different. It requires self-discipline and effort. You train by reading God's word to see His Godly qualities on display. You work and allow Him to work in you so that you can adopt those same qualities. You let God craft your heart into what it needs to be. You train by spending time with His people to be built up together and you spend time in prayer to be lifted up by God. You keep at it and don't give up.
