A New Advance for God's Kingdom

In commenting on Hebrews 13, F. F. Bruce wrote this:

"Time and again in the history of the people of God a similar call has come when a new advance must be made into the unknown and unfamiliar, to occupy fresh territory under the leadership of Jesus. There is nothing static about Him or his cause; to stand still is to fall behind him."

Bruce penned this far before the days of COVID, but his application of Scripture is just as relevant today as ever. God has consistently called his people—both Israel (Old Testament) and the Church (New Testament)—to pursue uncharted territory as soldiers and ambassadors in his kingdom.

I wonder: what are our "uncharted territories" that we need to occupy for Christ?

Do you think the Lord has work for us to do in the digital space with platforms like Zoom, YouTube, Facebook, Instagram, etc.?

Do you think there are needs in our community that no one has stepped in to fill, be it feeding the hungry, education, benevolence, or something else?

Do you think there are places in Columbus—yes, I said Columbus! — where people have still never meaningfully heard about Jesus?

Do you think there are deeper levels of Scriptural understanding that God is calling us to grow in and apply?

My friends, the more we begin to look for "uncharted territories" the more we find them. Uncharted territories are frightening because they are unknown. But Jesus is on the move! As Bruce says, "To stand still is to fall behind him."

For Paul, his desire was to preach the gospel beyond Rome—all the way to Spain (Rom 15:23-28). That was definitely uncharted territory, but he felt a deep obligation to take the gospel into the "unknown" (for example, read Rom 1:14-15). We don't know if he made it all the way there or not, but we do know that his life was a labor of following Jesus' lead!

If Jesus is on the move, let us be the first among his people to stand up and pursue the mission where Jesus has gone. One of the fundamental beauties of the early church is that it was not dependent upon "what has always been done" since they were the first ones—they just took the Scriptures and applied them to their situation. *May we follow in their example by doing the same!*

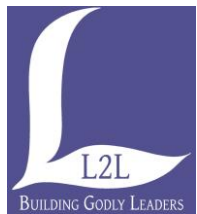

As you scroll through whatever social media you have, you will get recommendations. On Instagram you may see posts by people you don't know because you follow someone similar, so they are recommended to you. On YouTube when you click on one video you end up with a whole row of recommended videos. Even on Netflix and other streaming services there's usually a whole section of "because you watched" where it predicts shows that you may like. We follow the people and the channels that appeal to us. The ones that make us laugh, feel good, or make us really think. It's so easy to follow them too because all it takes is one click. One click, and we get everything they ever put out.

There is a recommendation that I make to you. Follow Jesus. This is a call to follow someone who has made a lasting impact on every single person who has ever lived and every person who will live. But to follow Him is more than what we might imagine. It isn't just taking His advice from time to time. It isn't just turning to Him when times are hard. To follow Jesus is to walk directly behind him, follow in His steps, truly learn from what He taught, and to live how He lived. This is a total commitment to the Son of God who offers total forgiveness for the totality of your sins.

Where does this begin? It begins with you accepting His offer. It begins with you receiving His forgiveness by His grace through baptism. As you think about following Him, read Romans 6:3-8 and consider the beauty of what is written. Choosing to follow Jesus is the wisest and best decision you can ever make in your entire life.
