## Hosanna

If you grew up in church, you probably heard this word in worship songs, sermons, and classes. You are likely familiar with the hymn that says: "Hosanna in the highest!" There are certain words ("hallelujah" is another one) that we hear repeatedly but may not necessarily have a clear view of what the terms actually mean. So, what is it that we mean when we sing and speak "hosanna"?

Let me start by giving a very brief explanation for why there are some words in our English translations that are not actually English words. It all comes down to a practice called *transliteration*. When you transliterate a word, you take the sound of the word in one language and use the corresponding letters in the second language to produce a similar sound. Let me explain. The word "baptism" is a transliteration of the Greek word "*baptisma*"—can you see how similar they are?

There are certain times when translators have decided it is better to *transliterate* a word rather than *translate* a word in the Bible. Maybe the original language term has already been adopted and widely used in the second language, maybe there is some ambiguity about the definition, or various other reasons.

The word "hosanna" is essentially a *transliteration* of two Hebrew words in the Old Testament. Those two words ("yasha anna") mean something like "please save us" or "save, I pray!" It is a call to God for deliverance and salvation.

In Psalm 118:25, a chapter we will look at in today's sermon, the Psalmist says: "Please save us, O Lord! O Lord, we pray, give us success."

When we sing "hosanna" we are both beseeching God for his salvation and also praising God for being more adequate than we are in ourselves. When we come to God with shouts of "hosanna," we are saying: "We can't save ourselves, God! We need you, Lord!"

That has been our focus for the last month or so. We have been standing at the foot of the cross, confronted with the depths of our unrighteousness and the immensely deeper depths of Christ's love for us. We can say nothing but *hosanna*!

### Copycat

When you look at how infants learn, so much of it is done by copying their parents. Think about a child learning to talk for the first time. They watch how other people talk and they begin to make the same sounds and shapes with their mouths. Soon enough they're able to talk. We also learn so much by watching and copying others.

Paul writes in 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 11:1, "*Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ.*" He also writes in Philippians 3:17, "*Brothers, join in imitating me, and keep your eyes on those who walk according to the example you have in us.*" The goal of imitating Paul is to live a life that reflects Christ. Paul was doing everything he could to live like Jesus, and you can tell that when you look at the example, he left behind for us.

Paul gave up his old life, humbled himself, and did what he could to bring others to Jesus. He preached Jesus to others even if it meant he would be beaten and imprisoned. Even when he was imprisoned, he still did what he could to spread the message of Jesus by writing letters.

For us, we need to examine our lives and see if we have truly emptied ourselves so that we can be filled with the purpose of Christ. Paul set a great example of living for Jesus. Watch and learn from Paul and imitate the example that he left.
