Run, Rise, Rest

George Herbert (early 17th century) once wrote this moving poem:

*Lord, who hast formed me out of mud,
And hast redeemed me through thy blood,
And sanctified me to do good;*

*Purge all my sins done heretofore:
For I confess my heavy score,
And I will strive to sin no more.*

*Enrich my heart, mouth, hands in me,
With faith, with hope, with charity;
That I may run, rise, rest with thee.*

Every line of this poem is packed with a rich spiritual message. In the first stanza, Herbert draws our attention to *creation and salvation*. God created our world from nothing and formed Adam and Eve from the dust of the ground (Genesis 1-2). Because of our sins, we had to be redeemed by the blood of Christ shed on the cross (Romans 5:9). When we are saved by Christ, we are also beginning a journey of being "sanctified" ("made holy") by God (1 Peter 1:2).

In the second and third stanzas, Herbert discusses our "sanctification" in more detail. We need continual "purging" of sin that creeps up in our lives. Consider David's words in Psalm 51: "Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow." While we might first think of "washing" as the moment of baptism (see Acts 22:16), it is important to remember that we are not perfect after baptism and our position "in Christ" keeps us perpetually "washed" (1 John 1:7).

Essential to following Jesus on the road to sanctification is the willingness to confess our faults (1 John 1:9) and strive to follow our Lord and the Word (John 14:15). But obedience is not merely an exercise in "rule keeping"! We are allowing the Holy Spirit to cultivate his "fruit" in us (Gal 5:22-25)— "keeping in step with the Spirit" *enriches* our lives!

Finally, we want to "run, rise, rest" with the Lord. We want to *run*, meaning we want to live this life abundantly in serving him (Col 3:17). We want to *rise* with the Lord, meaning we are anticipating the final resurrection (John 11:25). Lastly, we want to *rest* in the presence of God in glory forever (2 Cor 4:16-18). This poem could easily become our own prayer. May we run, rise, and rest with the Lord!
